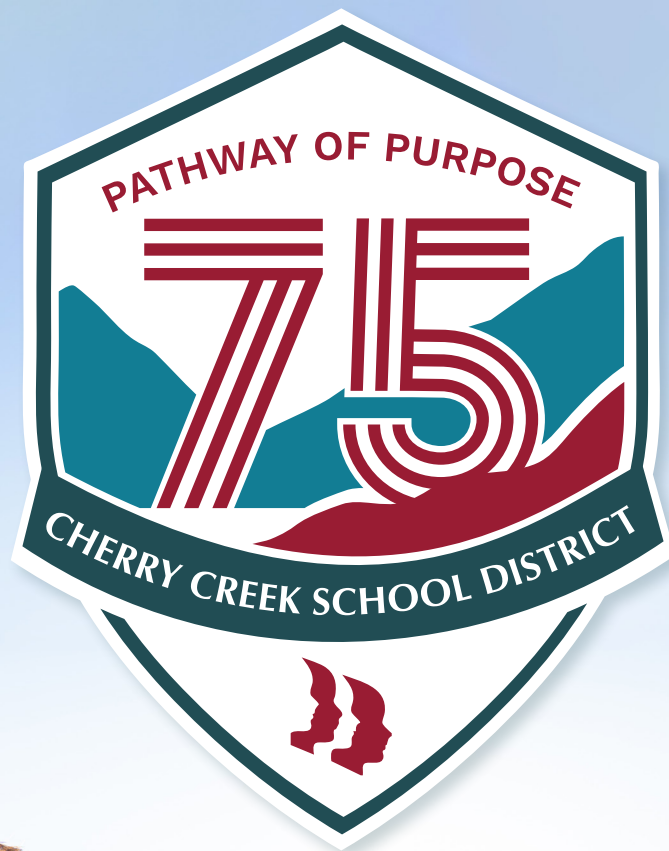

Dr. Jennifer Perry is the Interim Superintendent of the Cherry Creek School District, bringing nearly three decades of experience in education and 25 years in the District.

Since July 2021, Perry has served as the Deputy Superintendent, leading a variety of teams and initiatives across the district, including Strategic Planning, Curriculum and Performance Improvement, and Career and Innovation.

Prior roles within the district include Assistant Superintendent of Educational Operations, Executive Director of Elementary Education, Elementary Principal, Elementary Assistant Principal, and Teacher, specializing in 2nd-grade and Title I reading. Previously, Perry taught at Jefferson County Public Schools from July 1997 to June 2001, focusing on kindergarten and multi-age 1st and 2nd-grade classes.

Perry holds a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership and Policy Studies from the University of Northern Colorado, along with a Master's degree in School Administration and a Master of Education. Perry earned a Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education and Teaching from Metropolitan State University of Denver.

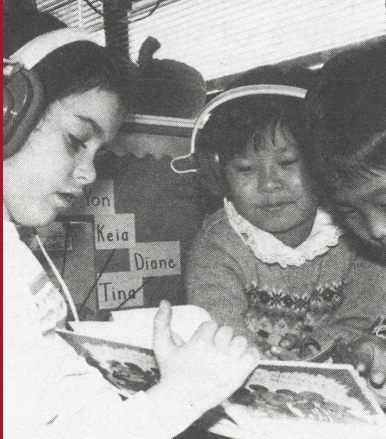

Aspiring Educator Pathway

This four-year, residency-style program pairs aspiring educators with CCSD teachers who serve as mentors. Participants gain more than 4,500 hours of real classroom experience, six times more than traditional student teaching, while working toward licensure through the Community College of Aurora. Now in its second year, the program has grown from 16 to 58 apprentice teachers across 15 schools, including special education programs. The results are clear: by addressing common challenges facing teachers today Cherry Creek is building a brighter future for both students and educators.

Cherry Creek Innovation Campus (CCIC)

Recognized as one of the top 100 schools in the world for educational innovation, CCIC offers transformative career pathways for all CCSD high school students. From Aerospace Engineering to Hospitality & Tourism, these nontraditional programs prepare students to enter technical fields and compete at a high level right after graduation.



Traverse Academy

Traverse Academy, opened in fall 2023, is the first district-operated mental health facility and school of its kind in the nation, created in response to the growing mental health needs of students across the Cherry Creek School District. Funded by the 2020 bond, Traverse serves students ages 10–18 with a unique blend of academic instruction and therapeutic support. Named after Colorado's four great mountain traverses, the school symbolizes the strength and resilience needed to overcome life's obstacles and reach new heights.
