Continuing to Strengthen School-Community Connections

On July 15, PPS hosted a successful Community Kickback in the East Hills neighborhood, where Families had the opportunity to complete the Future Ready Facilities Plan survey, learn about summer reading programs, and explore job opportunities. PPS staff and community partners were present to answer questions and provide tools to support student success.

During the Summer Leadership Academy, over 100 District leaders joined Dr. Walters and his Leadership Team for a special Community Conversation where participants shared feedback and posed questions about the PPS Future-Ready Facilities Plan.
