

French I Honors Syllabus

Course Description/Goals:

French I Honors deepens and exceeds the traditional French I level course by including a more in-depth and faster pace study of the French language. French I Honors introduces students to the French language and francophone culture. Communication focuses on using the four basic language skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing so students have ample opportunities to experience and practice French in meaningful ways to hold brief conversations. A student's proficiency level is developed through age-level appropriate and culturally authentic resources, high frequency vocabulary, and language structures to negotiate meaning through spoken and written text, and participate and respond to everyday life situations.
