1	AI-Assisted Idea Generation and Structuring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> AI can be used in the assignment for brainstorming, creating structures, and generating ideas for improving work. No AI content is allowed in the final submission. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Per the teacher's request, AI disclosure statements referencing how AI was used and submitted with final submission.
2	AI-Assisted Editing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> AI can be used as an editing tool to make improvements to student-created work. No new content can be created using AI. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> AI disclosure statements referencing how AI was used and submitted with final submission. Per teacher request, a copy of any AI chat(s) should be submitted with final submission.
3	AI for Specified Task Competition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> AI can be used to complete certain elements of an assignment based on teacher direction. Students are responsible for providing human oversight and evaluation of AI created content. You will use AI to complete specified tasks in your assignment. Any AI created content must be cited. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All AI created content must be cited using proper citations. Copy of any AI chat(s) must be submitted with final submission.
4	Full AI Use with Human Oversight	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You may use AI throughout your assignment to support your own work in any way you deem necessary. AI should be a tool to enhance your human creativity. You are responsible for providing human oversight and evaluation of all AI generated content. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All AI created content must be cited using proper citations. Copy of any AI chat(s) must be submitted with final submission.
