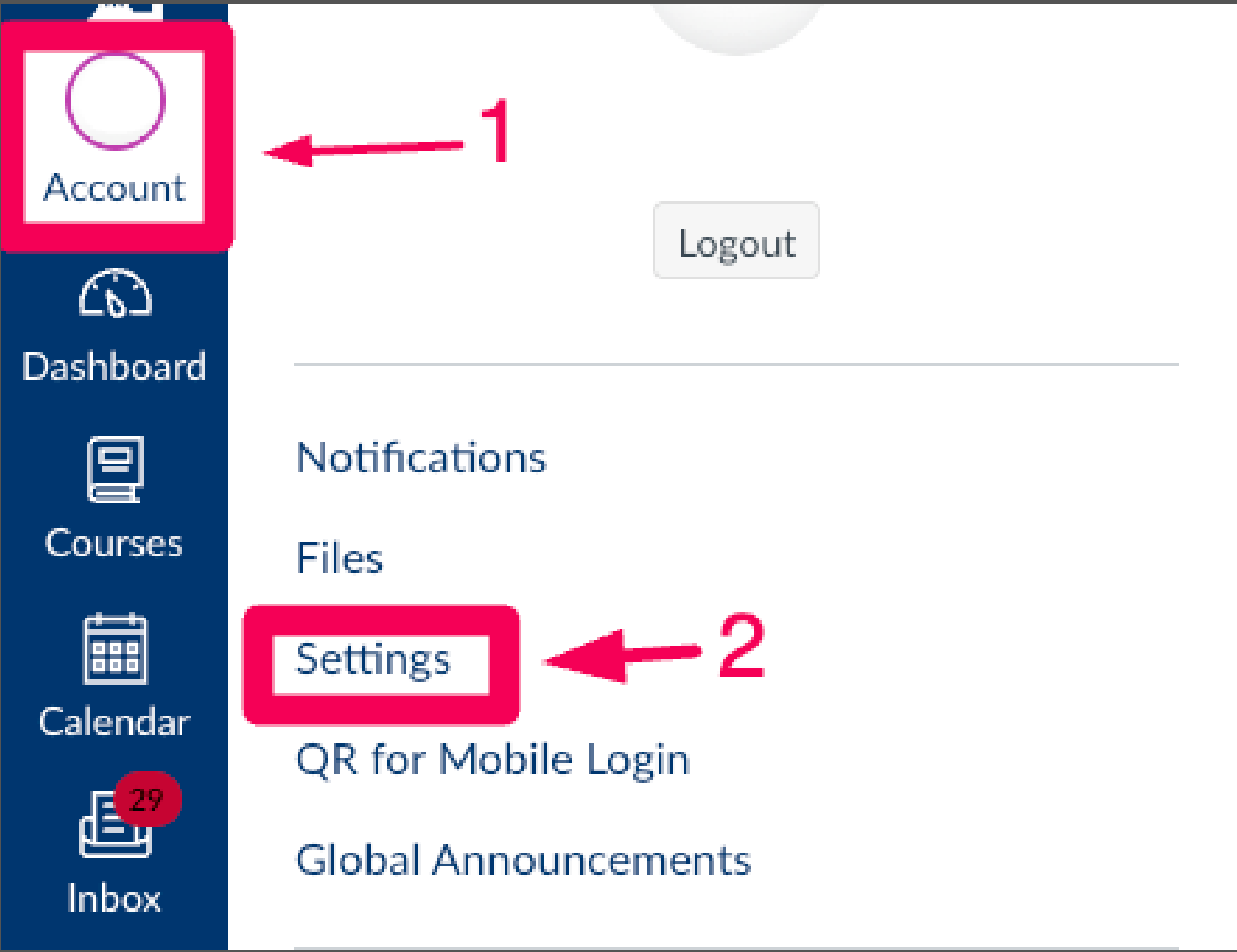

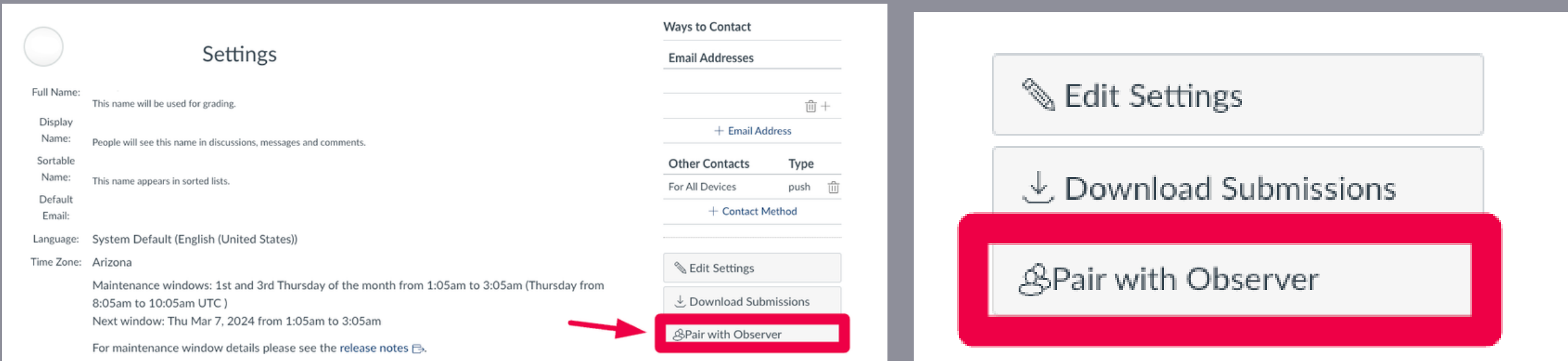
Canvas Parent/Guardian Pairing

This guide will help you easily create a Canvas account to observe your child’s online learning.

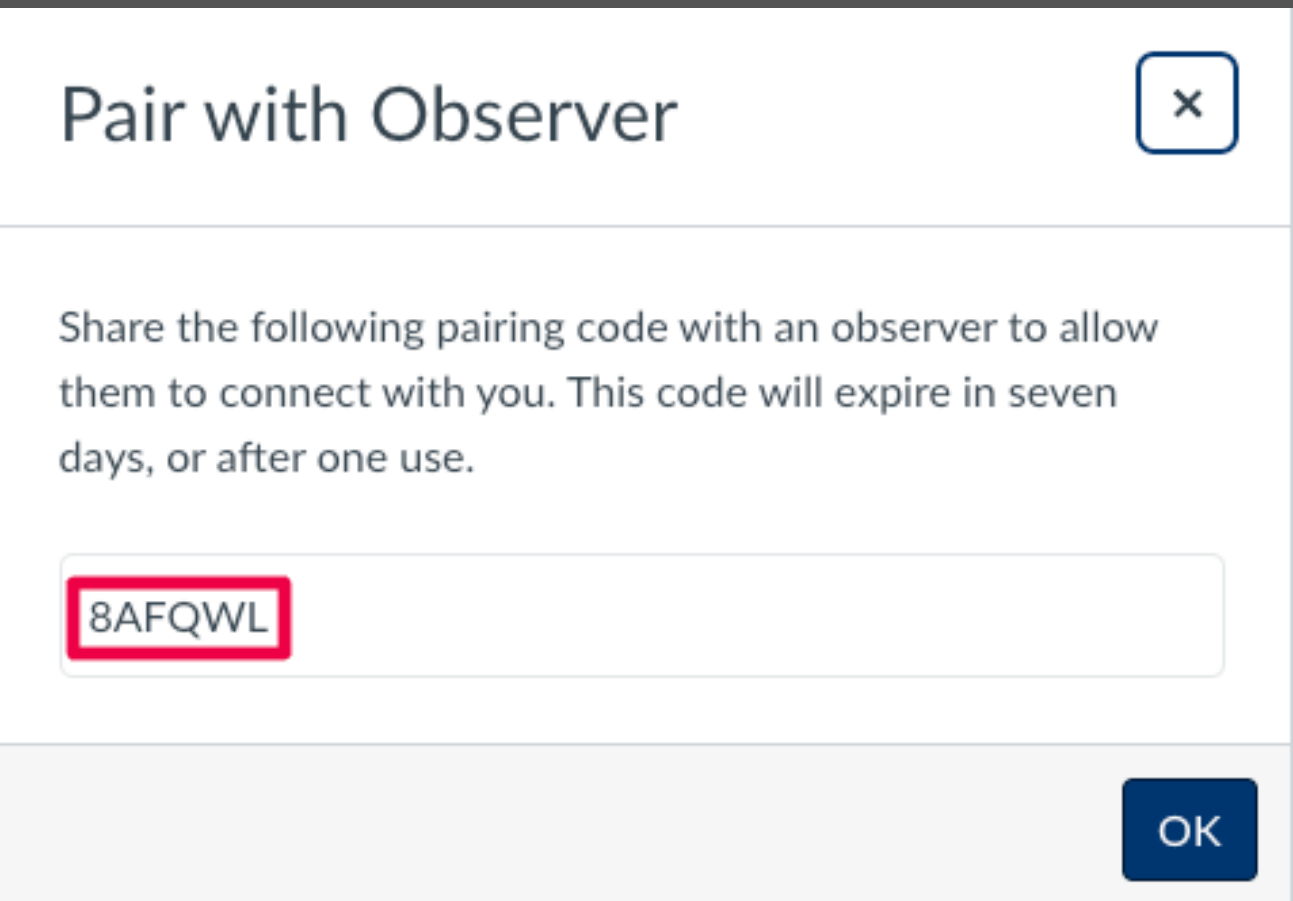
1 In your child’s Canvas account, access **Account Settings**.

3 After clicking **Pair with Observer**, copy the displayed pairing code.









5 On this page, create a new parent account.




