<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the MAP:</b>                      MAP is a computerized adaptive test which helps teachers, parents, and administrators improve learning for all students and make informed decisions to promote a child's academic growth. The MAP test is a screening tool and a tool to monitor student progress in Reading and Math. *KDG and 1<sup>st</sup> grade will <u>only</u> give the math assessment. KDG does not begin testing until May.</p>

<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of FastBridge Assessments:</b>                      earlyReading is an assessment of essential early reading skills, such as concepts of print, phonemic awareness, phonics, and fluency. earlyMath assesses skills including number identification, match quantity, number sequence, decomposing, story problems, and place value (depending on grade level).</p>

<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the SAEBRS and mySAEBRS:</b>                      SAEBRS is designed to help teachers determine students' social-emotional strengths and areas of need of further intervention. This assessment is completed by teachers. mySAEBRS is a student-rater companion assessment to SAEBRS, which allows students in grades 2-8 to self-assess their social, academic, and emotional behavior.</p>		

## CogAT, selected students in grades 2-7

<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the CogAT:</b>                      CogAT, which stands for Cognitive Abilities Test, is utilized to reflect a student's overall reasoning and problem solving abilities through a battery of verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal assessments. This data, along with other benchmark data, will be utilized to determine acceleration needs (ex: enrichment, GATE, and advanced math)</p>

<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the Amira:</b> Amira automates oral reading fluency, dyslexia risk screening, and running records. Amira reports will help teachers determine individual student needs in phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension.</p>		

## KIDS: Kindergarten Individual Development Survey

<b>Completed within the first 40 days of In-Person School</b> <b>Data Entry Window 10/13 thru 10/27</b>
<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of KIDS:</b> KIDS is an observation tool designed to help teachers understand the abilities and behaviors of our early learners. KIDS measures four domains: approaches to learning and self-regulation, social and emotional development, language and literacy development, and math cognition. Students are observed during play, work, and numerous other parts of the day.</p>

## ACCESS Testing for EL Students, Grades K-8

<b>1/14 thru 3/3</b> <b>Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing</b>
<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the ACCESS:</b> The ACCESS test is designed to assess student progress in achieving English language proficiency. Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing are assessed. The purpose of the test is to gauge student learning relative to content standards.</p>

## IAR, Grades 3-8

<b>3/3 thru 3/27</b>
<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the IAR:</b> IAR is designed to measure students' content knowledge and key skills of the Illinois State Standards. Students are assessed in English Language Arts and Math in grades 3-8 and Science in grades 5 and 8.</p>

## ISA, Grades 5 and 8

<b>4/13 thru 4/30</b>
<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the ISA:</b> ISA is designed to measure students' content knowledge and key skills of the Next Generation Science Standards. Students are only assessed in grades 5 and 8.</p>

## DLM-AA, Grades 3-8

<b>3/11 thru 5/6</b>
<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the DLM:</b> DLM-AA is designed for students with many types of significant cognitive disabilities. It is a completely individualized assessment designed so students can show what they know and can do in literacy, math, and science.</p>
