<p><b>Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the MAP:</b>                      MAP is a computerized adaptive test which helps teachers, parents, and administrators improve learning for all students and make informed decisions to promote a child's academic growth. The MAP test is a screening tool <u>and</u> a tool to monitor student progress in Reading and Math. *KDG and 1<sup>st</sup> grade will <b>only</b> give the math assessment. KDG does not begin testing until May.</p>

**Description of Assessment, What is Assessed, and Purpose of the CogAT:**

CogAT, which stands for Cognitive Abilities Test, is utilized to reflect a student's overall reasoning and problem solving abilities through a battery of verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal assessments. This data, along with other benchmark data, will be utilized to determine acceleration needs.
