



DID YOU KNOW...

We provide dental care to children in the Tredyffrin/Easttown and Great Valley school districts.

The Children's Dental Clinic is a non-profit community organization that provides dental treatment for children of families with financial need who are unable to access private dental care.

Treatment provided includes an oral exam, cleaning, fluoride treatment, x-rays when needed, fillings and any other treatment that the dentist is able to do at the Clinic. Each child is charged \$10 per visit, which helps pay for the services received. Many volunteers donate their time and energy to help the Clinic operate.

The Clinic operates on Thursdays during the school day. Appointments are scheduled a week or two in advance; families are asked to pay at the time of visits. You can help considerably by showing interest in the treatment that your children receive and by helping them care for their teeth – with good oral hygiene and diet.

All information on children who are treated at the Clinic is confidential. Please contact us by phone or visit the website to set up an appointment for your child.
