### 2025 – 2026 OPHS PTO POST PROM INFORMATION



The Post Prom Party is the largest PTO event of the year and will be held on May 30, 2026 immediately following Prom. The Post Prom Party is a safe, alcohol-free event for OP Seniors and their Prom dates. OP Seniors do NOT need to attend Prom in order to attend the Post Prom Party.

In past years, almost 400 students have attended the Post Prom Party. The students enjoyed entertainment, refreshments, and prizes. In 2025, the PTO gave away more than \$9,000 in prizes and \$2000 in cash, with one lucky senior winning the grand prize of \$2025.
