Early/Late drop off/Pick up

- Early Drop off- Breakfast gate will open at 7:45 a.m. and main gates at 8:00 a.m. For the safety of our students, we ask that **students do not come before 7:40 a.m.** There is no adult supervision before that time. Parents will be contacted for students arriving to school before 7:40 a.m.

- **Late Pick Up-** After school, students are expected to be picked up or walk home immediately. Please ensure prompt pick up by arriving to school early.

Volunteering

- We are excited to see so many parent volunteers on campus this year. We appreciate each and every one of you who take the time to come help make our students and school successful. We could not do it without you!
- Volunteers are needed for school events like Camp Landell, Jog-a-Thon, STEM Fest, Classroom Events, and many more!
- Prior approval from the teacher is required before coming on campus to assist in classrooms. This ensures effective coordination and maintains an optimal learning environment.

Volunteer Vs. Visitor

- **Visitor: May only visit 3 or less per school year.** This is strictly enforced. We will notify you on the third visit. All visits are logged in the Raptor system.
- **Volunteer: Unlimited Visits per school year.**
- TB test required: (received within 60 days and good for 4 years)
- Raptor application: (Completed annually) Can be found on the school website la.cypsd.org
- Please note: Approvals will only be done on Monday afternoons. Requests submitted mid-week will need to wait until the following Monday afternoon for approval.

Parent Volunteer guidelines:

- When volunteering, please stay in the designated space assigned.
- As a general rule, **volunteers should not be on the playground during recess and lunch times.**
- Please do not interrupt students during instruction time.
- Adults, regardless of volunteer status, should under no circumstances touch other students.
- Please do not take pictures or post photos/videos to social media unless directed by our principal, even if it is your own child. We need to protect the privacy of all students.
