Schedule for 2025 Dave Spurlock CCSD Football Jamboree Changed

Charleston, SC (August 13, 2025) – The lineup of exhibition matchups for the annual Dave Spurlock Charleston County School District (CCSD) Football Jamboree has been updated. The preseason event at West Ashley High School's Wildcat Stadium is still set for a 5:30 p.m. start on Friday, August 15, 2025. However, St. John's High School will not participate due to the team not having enough players ready at this time (the Islanders will still field a football team for the 2025 season).

8:00 p.m. – West Ashley Wildcats vs Baptist Hill Bobcats (24 minutes)

For each contest, the clock will stop as it would during a normal game.

Gates will open for fans starting at 4:30 p.m., and the district's clear bag policy will be enforced.

Tickets for the Dave Spurlock CCSD Football Jamboree are available for purchase for \$8 a person online (children five years old and under are free) at this [GoFan.co link](#). Attendees are asked to save their proof of purchase to their email accounts and present their digital tickets on their mobile devices at the gate. Fans can buy tickets with cash in person at the entrance on the day of the event. Proceeds from the ticket sales will benefit all 12 of the participating schools.
