

## SAFETY & SECURITY

> Completed state-required safety audit to ensure all exterior doors are locked & working properly



> ECISD police officers will conduct WEEKLY safety checks of fencing and exterior doors at all schools

> All classroom doors will remain locked all day, every day



- > ECISD police department, 64 full-time officers and 5 part-time officers
- > 4 K-9 units, 2 trained in drug detection and 2 trained in weapons detection
- > Officers assigned to all middle schools and high schools – 4 officers and 1 supervisor assigned to OHS & PHS
- > ECISD officers and other law enforcement agencies coordinate daily drive-by and walk-through patrols at elementary schools

- > Controlled access entrances at every school (funding from voter-approved Tax <u>Ratification Election</u> in 2018)
- > Nearly 1,000 portable radios connecting campus leaders to the ECISD Police Department
- > Alarm system that is set overnight and on weekends to detect unauthorized entry
- > 1,500 video cameras across the district, monitored by police
- > Door barricades in every classroom and school office as safety defense in a lockdown
- > Visitors must check in and wear visitor badge at all times
- > All staff must wear IDs at all times
- > ECISD uses state-approved
  Standard Response Protocol
  (SRP) to train all staff and
  students for Lockdown, Secure,
  Shelter and Evacuation incidents
- > See Something, Say Something ECISD operates a highly effective and successful Student Crime Stoppers program
- > ECISD has an Emergency Management Team and school Threat Management Teams
- > ECISD officers provide local training in active shooter response for other agencies
- > All officers trained in Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response (ALERRT), the training from the Texas School Safety Center for active shooter response
- > Coordinated plans among ECISD, Odessa Police Department, Ector County Sheriff's Office, DPS, UTBP, Odessa College, and Medical Center Health System police departments.
