WHAT'S NEW?

The design phase at Carl Traeger Elementary School is officially complete! As part of ongoing site planning efforts, the Oshkosh Area School District has received preliminary approval for a new traffic light at the east driveway on 20th Avenue, along with additional improvements to aid in traffic flow.

To gather feedback and keep the community informed, a neighborhood meeting has been scheduled for August 19 at 5:30 p.m. in the Carl Traeger Middle School cafetorium.

Representatives from the project's architectural team, traffic engineering firm, and traffic light designer will be in attendance to answer questions and hear community input. Following that meeting, the project will be formally presented to the City of Oshkosh's Transportation Committee for approval on September 9.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE


This update features final renderings of the four-classroom addition at Carl Traeger Elementary. The goal was to closely match the look and feel of the existing building. To that end, one rendering highlights the updated playground area—positioned in nearly the same location as the current one—with an added sidewalk wrapping around the building and a relocated asphalt play area further to the north. While some final site details are still being refined, building plans are set to be submitted for state review in August 2025, with bidding to follow in September, and bid submissions due back by October. Construction remains on track to begin in February/March 2026, with completion targeted for August 2026.

At Franklin and Oakwood Elementary Schools, design is now approximately 50% complete. The past four months have been a productive stretch—filled with floor plan refinements, evolving site layouts, exterior design exploration, and initial decisions around interior finishes. Stay tuned for a deeper dive into both schools with the September update.
