



# Summary of the Year

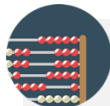
## GRADES PK-K

**OVERVIEW:** In Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten, students work in groups and individually, with teacher assistance, to develop foundational skills in academic learning and social development for the years to come.



### ENGLISH/LITERACY

- Apply phonics and word analysis skills
- Identify and form letters and sounds
- Recognize environmental print and sight words
- Read many types of informational and fictional texts
- Use comprehension strategies to retell, question, make connections and determine importance of text
- Use a combination of drawing, writing, and dictating to describe events
- Listen, speak clearly, and participate in class discussions



### MATH

- Count to 20 (PK); to 100 (K)
- Identify and use numbers up to 20
- Add and subtract using pictures and stories
- Add and subtract numbers up to 10
- Identify shapes, colors, and patterns
- Analyze, compare, and compose two- and three-dimensional shapes
- Compare length, weight, capacity, and numbers
