7. No food, drink, or gum in the band hall.

## Communication

As per Pearland ISD policy, the following are the only means of communication between teachers to families:

- Teacher to Parent (or vice versa): May only communicate via Skyward, email, or Canvas
- Teacher to Student (or vice versa): May only communicate via Canvas

- Playing & Written Tests
- Sectional Attendance
- Before/After-School Rehearsals
- Listening Assignments

- Solo Contest Participation
- Recorded Tests (Canvas/MakeMusic)

# Attendance Policy

## Excused Absences

An absence may be excused at the discretion of the band directors if one of the following applies:

- **Personal illness** (student absent from school that day)
- **Family emergency**
- **Death in the family**
- **Medical appointment** (must provide documentation)
- **Other serious circumstances** deemed appropriate by a director

## Requirements for excusal:

- Notify a band director **immediately via email**
- Provide documentation (e.g., parent email, medical note)

If a student misses a **performance**, they must contact a director immediately and will be assigned an **alternative assignment**.

## Unexcused Absences

An absence is unexcused if it does not have prior approval or falls under the following:

- Appointment without documentation
- Academic tutorials
- Club meetings
- Other extracurricular activities
- Oversleeping or forgetting the event

Unexcused absences may be made up for **partial credit (70)** through an alternative written assignment.

Band/Athletic Students: Band Directors go to great lengths to schedule based on sports seasons. The directors and coaches have a few absolutes to help our shared band/athletic members when planning rehearsals and sectionals:

- Band/Athletic students will NEVER miss a game/meet/match/etc.
- Band/Athletic students will NEVER miss the day BEFORE a game/meet/match/etc.

If a band rehearsal/event conflicts with sports practice, coaches allow students to miss **one practice without penalty**. Mr. Bennett and the coaches will coordinate absences directly via email. Students should **inform both the band directors and coaches** of any conflicts—communication is a shared responsibility between all parties.

## Academic Eligibility (No Pass, No Play)

- Students must maintain a 70 or above in all classes to participate in extracurricular events.
- Ineligible students may rehearse but not perform for 3 school weeks.
- Eligibility can be regained after the waiting period with passing grades.
- Concerts (Fall, Winter, Pre-UIL, Spring) and UIL Evaluations are **curricular** and participation is required regardless of eligibility status.
- Progress reports can affect eligibility; note the 2nd progress report of the 1st Nine Weeks can cause loss of eligibility.

## Required Supplies

### Tuner/Metronome

- Recommended: TonalEnergy App (\$7.99, iOS/Android/Amazon) — advanced features and affordable
- Free apps are acceptable but may have limited features

## Band Binder

Must include:

- Black 1.5" or 2" three-ring binder with pockets
- 3-hole pencil bag
- 5 sharpened pencils
- 1 highlighter
- 10+ sheets of notebook paper
- 5-tab dividers labeled: Fundamentals, Scales & Technique, Daily Drill, Music, Private Lesson Material

## Instrument Supplies

- Flute: Silk swab, tuning rod, plugs, foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Oboe/Bassoon: 4 reeds, reed case, water cup, silk swab, seat strap (bassoon), foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Clarinet/Bass Clarinet & Saxophones: 4 reeds, reed case, silk swab, mouthpiece cap, neck strap, (sax), foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Trumpet: Valve Oil, foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Horn: Rotary Oil, foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Trombone: Slide Oil, small squirt bottle for slide water, foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Euphonium: Valve Oil, foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Tuba: Rotary Oil, foldable music stand (for home practice)
- Percussion: IP RS251 VIB Mallets, IP MB-1 Stick/Mallet Bag, IP LD Snare Sticks, IP 3106B Marimba Mallets, IP GTX-5 TIMP, IP RP-1R XYLO/BELL Mallets ([www.steveweissmusic.com](http://www.steveweissmusic.com))

## Concert Uniforms

### Formal Uniform (Updated for 2025–2026)

- Students fitted Aug 20 & 21, 5:15–7:00 PM (Main Band Hall)
- Ordered through First Chair Formal Wear:
  - Men's black tuxedo shirt/blouse – required (\$28)
  - Women's black formal blouse – required (\$32)
  - BMJH red long tie – required for boys (\$16)
  - BMJH red/white pearl necklace – required for girls (\$16)
  - Hemmed tuxedo pants – highly recommended (\$52)
- Items to purchase separately:
  - Solid black dress pants (if not ordering tuxedo pants)
  - Solid black dress shoes (closed toe for girls)
  - Solid black belt (if pants have beltloops)
  - Solid black socks & solid black undershirts

### Informal Uniform

- Berry Miller Junior High Band t-shirt (provided yearly, covered by band fee)
  - Blue Jeans and/or khaki material type shorts
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## Sectionals

- Small group rehearsals by instrument once per week (except Concert Band 2, which has occasional full rehearsals)
  - Focus on instrument-specific technique beyond full band class
  - Required and graded as a major portion of the course
  - Attendance is required; notify directors ASAP about conflicts
  - Directors coordinate schedules with coaches to avoid conflicts with games/practices
  - Missing one sectional means missing over 10% of sectional content for the grading period
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## Listenings / Pass-Offs

- 10–15 minute individual help sessions with directors
  - Required for all students and count as major grades
  - Students select their own time slots
  - Provide focused feedback on region music, solos, or UIL music
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## Flexibility & Scheduling

- Directors work with coaches and sponsors to allow participation in all activities
- Coaches allow band/athletic students to miss one practice for band sectionals without any penalty
- Sectional schedules may adjust with sports seasons
- Guaranteed no missed games or pre-game practices for athletes due to sectionals

## Concerts & Major Performances

### Concerts

- Required and graded major events each grading period
- Demonstrate growth and performance skills

### Solo Contest

- Required for all junior high students
- Students perform independently with accompanist (\$40 fee paid directly)

### Pearland ISD Pre-UIL Contest

- Required for Honors, Symphonic, and Concert Band 1
- Prepares students for UIL Contest and sight-reading
- Requires 90% attendance in rehearsals, sectionals, listenings

### UIL Concert & Sight-Reading Evaluation

- Most important event for Symphonic and Concert Band 1
- One of the more important events for the Honors Band
- Bands perform prepared music and sight-read new music for judges
- Ratings from Superior (I) to Poor (V); Sweepstakes awarded for Superior in both

## Local Festivals

- Spring events such as Shadow Creek Showcase of Sound
- Judged with “Best in Class” awards

## Recording Competitions

- Honors Band participates in TMEA State Honor Band (odd years) and National Wind Band Honors contests (every year)
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## Required Fees

- **PISD Band Course Fee:** \$35 (covers clinicians, music, supplies, shirts) — pay via Skyward
  - **PISD Instrument Rental Fee:** \$120 annually for school-owned instruments — pay via Skyward
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## Fundraisers

### Rock-A-Thon Fundraiser supports:

- Why is this important?
- One time per year
- Spring Trip costs
- Private lesson scholarships
- Supplies & music
- Contest entry fees & transportation
- Clinicians
- General student support
- Phone/Text Fundraiser – how does that work with HB 1481?
  - During school fundraiser set up using school devices during classes.
  - After school when students are at home, student will activate the fundraiser on their personal devices.
  - During school fundraiser participation party!
    - Held during class using Pearland ISD device – as per HB 1481, students are not allowed to use personal smart devices during the school day (7:45 am – 3:55 pm).

## Private Lessons

- Highly encouraged for all students
  - Required for students playing school-owned instruments
  - Instructors include professionals and symphony musicians
  - Personalized instruction accelerates musical growth
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## Berry Miller Junior High Band Spring Trip

- Annual reward trip for hard work
- 2025 Destination: Six Flags Over Texas, Dallas
- Includes performance at Bluebonnet Festival plus theme park time
