If a peer falls, ask them if they are ok or need help.	Wait your turn  Give others space and privacy  Provide or get help from an adult for a peer in need
<b>Wisely Balanced</b>	Wait your turn when entering and exiting  Set a good example by sitting in a seat.	Wait your turn when entering and exiting classrooms  Walk in hallways with hands and feet to self Hold onto the banister walking up and down stairs	Walk quietly  Keep hands and feet to self	Wash your hands before eating  Walk with hands and feet to self. <b>Reflective Inquirer</b>	Ask Questions if unsure about bus safety	If unsure of rules in the hallway observe others and/or ask questions.
