 - i. Scoring: Please see that the scoring for FUNCTIONS of behavior consists of
 - ii. Escape: To stay away from objects or situations at school that make the child feel unpleasant physical symptoms or general distress,
 - iii. Avoid: To avoid social or evaluative situations at school that is painful to the child (school-related performance situations).
 - iv. Attention/To get: To receive attention from a parent or significant other
 - v. Tangible/To get: To obtain tangible rewards that make staying home more enjoyable/comfortable than going to school
