



Steps to Specific and Contingent Error Correction:

1 minute or less!

Example: “Joe [privately and with sincere voice tone], I saw that you were talking to your neighbor during independent work time.

Remember that *Doing your Best* means to focus on your own work. Start on your work again, and I’ll stop by to catch you focusing on your own work.”

1. Respectfully address student

2. Describe inappropriate behavior

3. Describe expected behavior/rule

4. Link to expectation on Matrix (Best Practice)

5. Redirect back to appropriate behavior by ending with encouragement
