Parent Login IDs follow the format: parentfirstname.parentlastname All lower case, no spaces

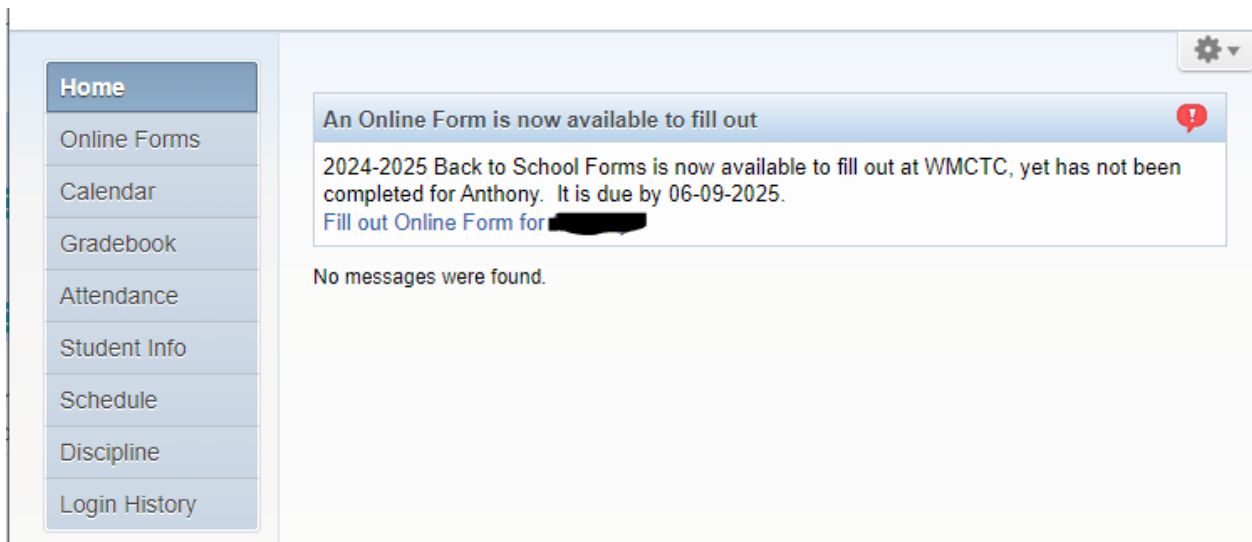
Parent password: wildcats77!

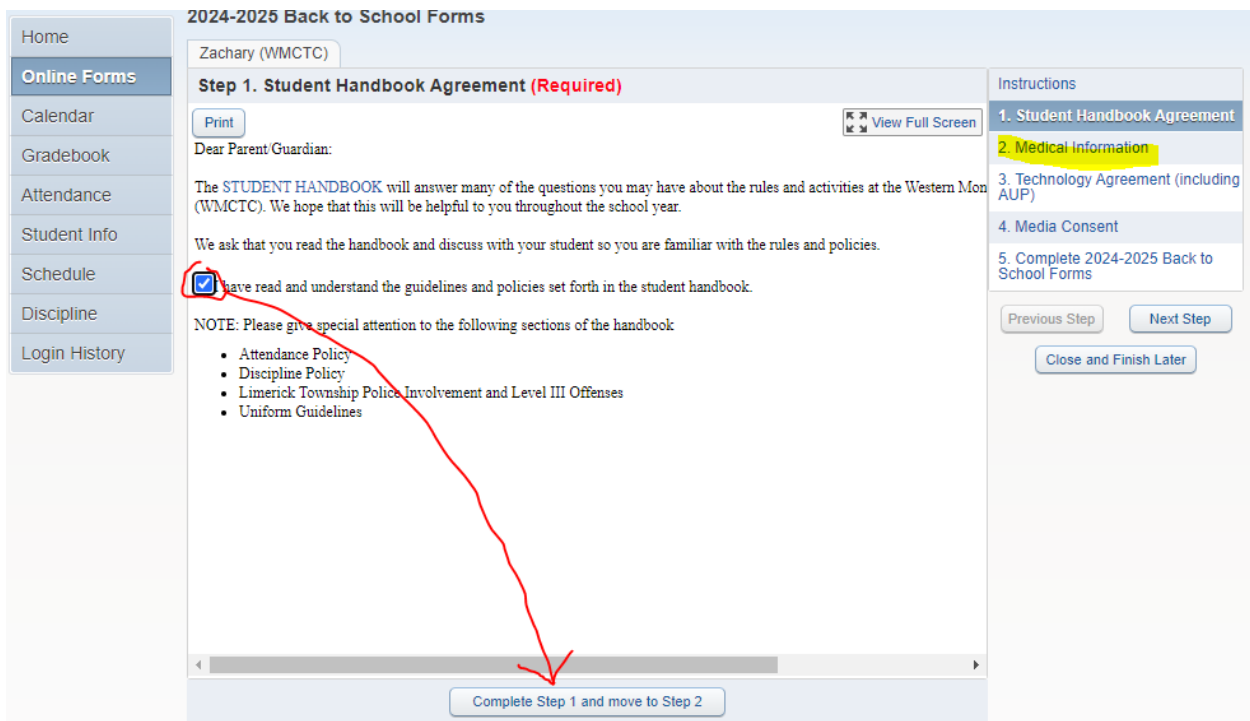

The following Standing Order medications may be administered by the school nurse, with parent permission, during regular school hours:

- Treatment based on nurse assessment and discretion when alternate comfort measures are unsuccessful
- Not to exceed 2 doses/week
- Individual medication order required from student's physician after 5 visits for complaint requiring a standing order medication (e.g., asthma, migraines, cramps and orthodontic pain)

Acetaminophen (Tylenol) 160mg-650mg

Ibuprofen (Motrin) 100mg-400mg

Antacids 1-2 tabs

Lozenge Throat Spray

Oral Anesthetic - for canker sores or tooth pain

The following Emergency medications may be administered by the school nurse on an emergency bases, with written parent permission, during regular school hours.

Diphenhydramine (Benadryl) 12.5mg-50mg

Epinephrine Auto Injector 0.15mg-0.3mg

Naloxone Nasal Spray 4mg in 0.1ml
