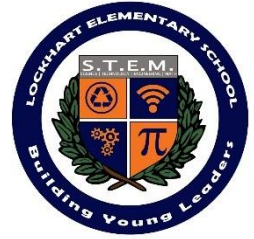

- **Parent Input and Decision-Making:** Parents will have opportunities to share input on Title I programs, policies, and plans through meetings, surveys, and written feedback.
- **Support for Learning at Home:** We will provide families with strategies, resources, and workshops to help students succeed academically, including literacy and math tips, test preparation, and digital learning tools.
- **Community Resources and Partnerships:** We will connect families with community resources, after-school programs, and support services to remove barriers to student success.
