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

# Read180 Student Growth

Students using Read 180 are placed in two different programs based on their individual needs. Students using Comp focus on building their reading comprehension skills. Students using Code focus on building their foundational reading skills.

## Growth Overview: Comp & Code Students



When averaged together, students using Read180 gained an average 9 RIT points on the NWEA MAP Reading assessment, increasing from 191 in Fall to 200 in Spring, outpacing typical annual growth expectations of 6.

# Read 180 Usage by Grade



Grade 9 shows the strongest engagement, averaging 80 days of Read 180 use, 16.3 minutes per day (within the 15–25-minute target range), and 7.1 instructional segments, the highest across all grades.
