<u>Supplies</u>: Students will need their science journal (composition book) daily in class along with a pencil and occasionally need markers/map pencils, scissors, and glue.

In this case, the student will be given an alternate assignment.

Grading Policy:

25% - Homework, Class assignments, Vocabulary

25% - Quizzes, Group/Class Labs, Daily Warm-Up

50% - Tests/Projects

^{**}Any extreme behavior will result in immediate office referral**

<u>Absent Work</u>: Absences allow the student one day to make up work for each day absent or an equitable arrangement with the teacher. It is the <u>responsibility of the student</u> to make arrangements with the teacher to do make-up work. A grade of "0" will be recorded for work or any assignments not turned in. Students with extracurricular and co-curricular absences are to get assignments from teachers **BEFORE** they leave, if possible.

Retesting: Any student may complete corrections/retest at the discretion of the teacher to earn up to a 70. Students must speak with me to discuss options.

Cheating: Cheating will not be tolerated. If any cheating occurs, district policy will be enforced. Per district policy, there will be no option to redo/retest the assignment.

Cell Phones: Students are not allowed to use their cell phones during the school day. We will enforce the cell phone policy stated in the student code of conduct. This includes the use of Apple Watches.

Communication: It is of the utmost importance to me that you communicate with me about any needs your child has or any questions you may have. The best form of communication is an email. I will always respond in a timely manner.
