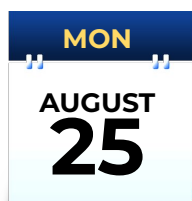

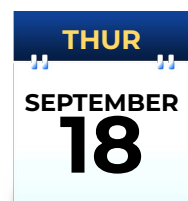

UNIFORM INFORMATION & DRESS CODE

ELEMENTARY BOYS (K - 4TH)

- Solid **Navy Blue** uniform pants with solid **Black** belt (No Dickie or cargo pants are permitted.)
- Solid **Navy Blue** Khaki Shorts with solid **Black** belt are permitted in the months of August, September, May, and June. Shorts length should not exceed above the knee.
- Long or short-sleeve solid **White** button-down dress shirt (Must include solid **Navy Blue** tie) or long or short-sleeve solid **White** polo shirt
- Solid **Navy Blue**, solid **Black**, or solid **White** socks
- Solid **Black** “non-marking” shoes (solid **Black** sneakers are acceptable.) **No colors may be on the soles, in the logos, or in the designs.** (All shoes are required to cover the entire foot with no opening.)
- Solid button-down **Navy Blue** uniform sweater

ELEMENTARY GIRLS (K - 4TH)

- Solid **Navy Blue** pleated uniform skirt. Skirts length should not exceed above the knee. Girls are not permitted to wear uniform pants, dresses, or shorts.
- Long or short-sleeve solid **White** button-down peter pan collar blouse (Must include solid **Navy Blue** criss-cross tie) or long or short-sleeve solid **White** polo shirt (Ruffles, bows, or extra design on sleeves are not permitted)
- Solid button-down **Navy Blue** uniform sweater
- Solid **Navy Blue** or Solid **White** socks, tights, or stockings (No leggings)
*Stockings/tights and socks must be the same color if wearing both with the uniform.
- Solid **Black** “non marking” shoes (solid **Black** sneakers are acceptable.) **No colors may be on the soles, in the logos, or in the designs.** (All shoes are required to cover the entire foot with no opening.)

MIDDLE SCHOOL BOYS (5TH - 8TH)

- Solid **Navy Blue** uniform pants with solid **Black** belt (No Dickie or cargo pants are permitted.)
- Solid **Navy Blue** Khaki Shorts with solid **Black** belt are permitted in the months of August, September, May, and June. Shorts length should not exceed above the knee.
- Long or short-sleeve solid **White** button-down dress shirt (Must include solid **Navy Blue** tie) or long or short-sleeve solid **White** polo shirt
- Solid **Navy Blue**, solid **Black**, or solid **White** socks
- Solid **Black** “non-marking” shoes (solid **Black** sneakers are acceptable.) **No colors may be on the soles, in the logos, or in the designs.**
- Solid button-down **Lipstick Red** uniform sweater

MIDDLE SCHOOL GIRLS (5TH - 8TH)

- **Navy, Red, Plaid** uniform skirt by French Toast. Skirts length should not exceed above the knee. Girls are not permitted to wear uniform pants or shorts.
- Long or short-sleeve solid **White** button-down peter pan collar blouse with **Bright Red** or **Red, Blue, and White** Plaid criss-cross tie same as uniform skirt or long or short-sleeve solid **White** polo shirt
- Solid button-down **Lipstick Red** uniform sweater
- Solid **Red, Black, or Blue** socks, tights, or stockings (No leggings)
*Stockings/tights and socks must be the same color if wearing both with the uniform.
- Solid **Black** “non marking” shoes (solid **Black** sneakers are acceptable.) **No colors may be on the soles, in the logos, or in the designs.** (All shoes are required to cover the entire foot with no opening.)

K - 8 Students

Students are not permitted to wear wedges, slippers, heels, platforms, open back shoes, or Crocs with their uniforms nor for dress down days.

CHAPEL UNIFORM (BOYS)

- Solid **Navy Blue** uniform pants with solid **Black** belt (No Dickie or cargo pants are permitted.)
- Long or short-sleeve solid **White** button-down dress shirt (Must include solid **Navy Blue** tie)
- Solid **Black** “non marking” shoes (solid **Black** sneakers are acceptable). **No colors may be on the soles, in the logos, or in the designs.**

CHAPEL UNIFORM (GIRLS)

- Designated uniform skirt
- Long or short-sleeve solid **White** button-down peter pan collar blouse (Must include designated criss-cross tie)
- Solid **Black** “non marking” shoes (solid **Black** sneakers are acceptable). **No colors may be on the soles, in the logos, or in the designs.**

GYM UNIFORM (Students can wear any color sneakers on their Gym Day only.)

- **Navy Blue** Cornerstone gym tee-shirt from any year or **Navy Blue** Cornerstone gym long-sleeve T-Shirt in the winter. Solid **Navy Blue** non-marking sweatshirt is allowed over the tee-shirt.
- Solid **Navy Blue** sweatpants (Students may not wear yoga, cargo, or track pants.) Other designs or logos are not permitted. (Cornerstone logos on sweatpants are permitted.)

COLD WEATHER

During the winter, students are permitted to wear hoodies, pullover sweaters, pants under skirts, and boots as a protection against the cold. These articles of clothing must be removed upon arrival at the school. Coats and hoodies that are worn to school must be kept in lockers or cubbies during the school day. Students may retrieve them for recess/outdoor activities only. Hats and hoods may be worn during outdoor activities. **Black** non-marking boots for snow days are acceptable.

HAIR/HEAD COVERING

Boys’ clothing and hair should remain neat and well presented. Boys are permitted to wear braids and locks (Only natural colors permitted); however, they must be neat and well presented. Colored hair, colored patches, or designs shaved in hair are not allowed. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings, bracelets, necklaces, chains, piercings, bandannas, or head wraps. Head coverings of any kind must be removed upon entrance to school facilities and remain off while on campus (List not limited to scarves tied around heads, hats, bandannas, or hoods are not permitted.) Boys are permitted to wear one watch and one ring. Fingernails are to be neatly manicured and of a reasonable length, not to exceed ¼” beyond the finger tip. Tattoos and henna are not permitted.

Girls’ clothing and hair should remain neat and well presented. Colored hair, colored patches, or designs shaved in hair are not allowed. Girls are permitted to wear natural colored hair and extensions. Head coverings of any kind must be removed upon entrance to school facilities and remain off while on campus (List not limited to scarves tied around heads, hats, bandannas, or hoods are not permitted.) Only small post earrings are permitted (no hoops or long earrings). Ladies are permitted to wear one watch and one ring. Necklaces, chains, bracelets, bangles, anklets, or body piercings are not permitted. Fingernails are to be neatly manicured and of a reasonable length, not to exceed ¼” beyond the finger tip (Pointy nails are not permitted). Tattoos and henna are not permitted.

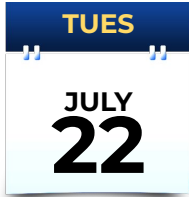

Parent Flat Rate Program 2025-2026

Students must live 1.5+ miles away to be eligible. Note: The School District determines the distance from your home to the school. Cornerstone is not responsible for determining distances from home to school. For the parents requesting to enroll in the Flat Rate Program, the parent/guardian can sign up via the School District of Philadelphia Transportation website; open enrollment is June 1 - October 1, 2025.

Transportation Sign Up Sheet 2025-2026

In Pennsylvania, school districts are required to provide transportation to students attending non-profit, private schools if schools are located within 10 miles of the district's boundary. In order to arrange for transportation, parents must contact their local school district and request that their child be transported to and from Cornerstone. The school district will contact Cornerstone to verify the student's enrollment. Communication about the bus route and timing will be provided by the school district to the parent and to Cornerstone.

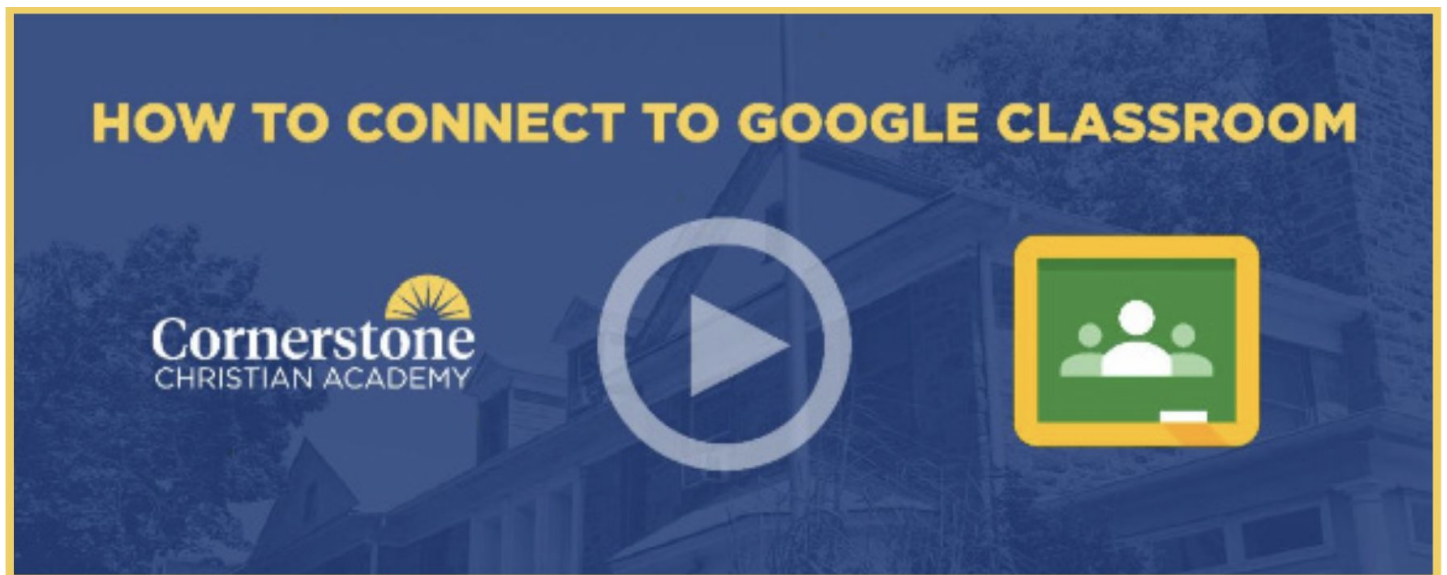
AT-HOME DEVICES
