My name is Scott McKee and I am your child's Carpentry instructor this school year. As part of my evolving classroom policy, I am requiring that each of my students share with their parents or guardians, the information they have recently received concerning the expectations for their performance in my class. I ask that you review the requirements and then, along with your child, sign the attached acknowledgment form.


The system to determine grades will be conducted in three areas: **Theory work, lab work and participation.** **Theory work** is information given to the students by the instructor. This is the information deemed necessary in order to fully comprehend any job the student may encounter. The theory grade is worth 25% of the student's overall grade. **Lab work** is the area in which the student will apply what he/she have learned in the theory part of instruction. Evaluation is based on skills, competencies, projects, procedures, safety, and equipment used. Lab work is worth 25% of the student's overall grade. **Participation** is taking part in the class. It is not only answering when being called on or reading for example, but actively participating in discussion and offering help to others in theory and lab. It also includes being prepared to gain knowledge, skills, as well as a positive attitude. Participation is worth 50% of the student's overall grade.

The following percentage scale will be used:

- 100 – 90 = A
- 89 – 80 = B
- 79 – 70 = C
- 69 – 60 = D
- Below 60 = E or failing

First year Carpentry students will need a 12 – 25 foot tape measure, safety glasses, and leather work boots *for the first day of school.* . Each student will order a uniform t-shirt from a link on the schools website after the start of the school year. The materials for the required first project are of no cost to the student; however, if a student wishes to complete an additional project(s) and are approved to complete the desired project(s), the student is responsible for paying for the needed materials.
