David Paterson Elementary School, in alignment with New York State's Education Law § 2803, is committed to provide the best possible learning environment for our students. Therefore, we are implementing the "No Cell from Bell to Bell" policy effective August 1, 2025.

Beginning on this date, all students will be **required to lock their cell phones in designated secure storage areas upon arrival at school**. Phones will remain locked during school hours and will be returned to students at the end of the day.

This new policy is intended to:

- Promote a focused and respectful classroom environment
- > Reduce distractions from social media, texting, and games
- Encourage face-to-face communication and engagement
- Improve overall academic performance

We understand that technology plays an important role in our daily lives, but we are confident this change will lead to a more focused and productive school experience for your child.

- Upon arrival, students will place their phones in a secure, locked storage locker in their classroom.
