Enrollment Process for Clinic Services

1. Consent forms for clinic services are sent through the parent portal or distributed at school events.
2. Students visit the school nurse's office for a walk-in screening.
3. The nurse obtains parent consent if qualifying symptoms are present.

4. PVHC Clinic Pediatric Care Coordinator (PCC) verifies insurance information and initiates the visit.

Enrollment Process for Mental Health Services

1. School counselors recommend students for Campus Care services.
2. Interested parents are referred to the Campus Care Navigator.
3. The Navigator contacts parents for enrollment paperwork and discount program details.
4. Once all documents are collected, the Navigator schedules the initial therapy session for parents and students, in-person or virtually.

Qualifications for Campus Care

- Parental consent is required.
- No residency restrictions.
- We accept all major insurances.
- No insurance, no problem we take uninsured individuals too.
- Referrals only from school counselors or school nurses.
- We help students struggling with mental health concerns, excluding acute crises.
- Not for active suicide cases.
- No double-dipping with multiple therapy providers simultaneously.
