Grading Terms and Class Structure

The school year consists of two 18-week semesters of classes. Students' schedules typically include six classes each semester. Classes are 55 minutes long and meet five times per week. GPS offers online classes through Gilbert Global Academy. There is not a limit on the number of courses students may take, or re-take online. Students may audit one class per semester which earns an S/U grade and does not calculate into the GPA.

Graduation Requirements

A minimum of 22 credits must be earned to meet graduation requirements. Specific requirements are listed below. The remaining necessary credits are considered elective credits and may be selected from any course in the curricular offerings. Each class receives ½ credit per semester.

Grading

Campo Verde High School computes a weighted and an unweighted GPA which includes all secondary-level courses on the transcript. Transfer credits are included in the calculation. CVHS reports class rank which is based upon the weighted, cumulative GPA.

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Cumulative GPA and Class Rank

The cumulative grade point average (GPA) is computed at the end of each semester. All class letter grades are used to compute the GPA. Students may retake a class for grade replacement and the highest grade is used to compute GPA and rank. Class rank is determined by the weighted, cumulative GPA.

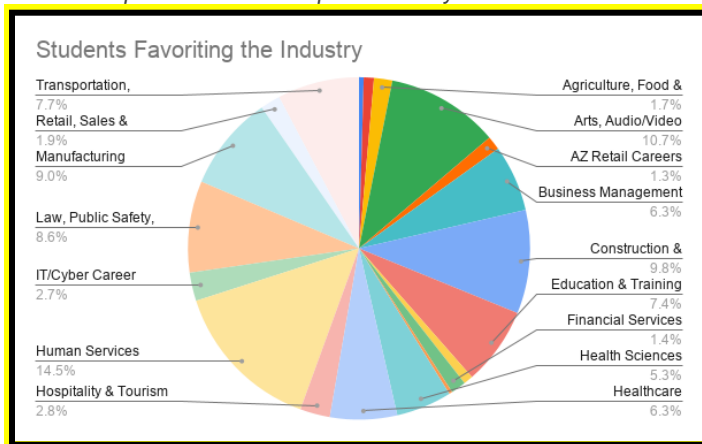
