



Tier 1 Infraction Policy

Infractions

- 1st Infraction - Warning for the student
- 2nd Infraction - One-on-one reflection with Coach Aubrie
 - Time with student scheduled within 24-hours of receiving infraction
 - Reflection on actions
- 3rd Infraction and Beyond - Detention and referral to Dean of Students (Tier 2).

*Parent/Guardian will be notified following each infraction via phone call/email.

Detention

1. Detention must be served within two (2) days of being notified that detention has been assigned.
2. Detentions are served on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings (7 to 8 a.m.) with Coach Aubrie.
3. Detentions must be served on the assigned day.
 - a. Students who are absent on their assigned detention day must serve their detention on the *next* scheduled detention day.
4. Students who are late for detention (beyond the grace period of five-minutes) will have their detention rescheduled.
5. Students who skip or reschedule their detention more than three times will have an additional detention assigned.
6. Student-athletes with morning practices are not exempt from detention.
7. Students serving detention may participate in restorative activities, such as:
 - a. Campus beautification/ volunteer opportunities (no hours can be accrued)
 - i. ex: classroom clean-up, Weight Room/ Library organization etc.
 - b. Electronic devices and homework completion will not be permitted.
8. Excessive detentions and/or referrals to the Dean of Students may result in disciplinary probation or referral to the Discipline Review Board.
