What is the Lummi Johnson O'Malley Program

The Lummi Nation Johnson O'Malley (JOM) program promotes educational success by providing quality supplemental financial and educational support services, that address the unique educational needs of JOM eligible students.

Who is eligible?

- Students at least ¼ degree Indian blood, enrolled in a Federally Recognized tribe/Alaskan Native.
- Age three (3) through grade twelve (12), attending Lummi Nation School, Ferndale Schools, or Lummi students attending outlying public schools.
- *Descendants with at least one (1) parent or one (1) grandparent enrolled in a Federally Recognized Tribe: **Must provide proof.**

What Services are provided?

❖ After School Tutoring

- Grades 2 through 12th attending public school

❖ Transportation (*based on availability*)

- Missed bus/Illness at school
- Parent/Teacher Conferences, IEP Meetings
- Students must reside on or near the Lummi Reservation

❖ *Financial Assistance- *\$50 cap amount for selected services.*

- School curricular/extra-curricular activities
- Running Start Fees (\$500 max)
- ASB cards (student athlete)
- Class fees/fines
- Technology Insurance
- Other needs: eyeglass hardware, school supplies

❖ Senior graduates

- \$150 Senior Grad Incentive to be used towards: caps, gowns, tassels, sashes, and senior pictures (**senior pictures for Lummi students ONLY**) .
- Senior Recognition Night
- Graduation Banners
