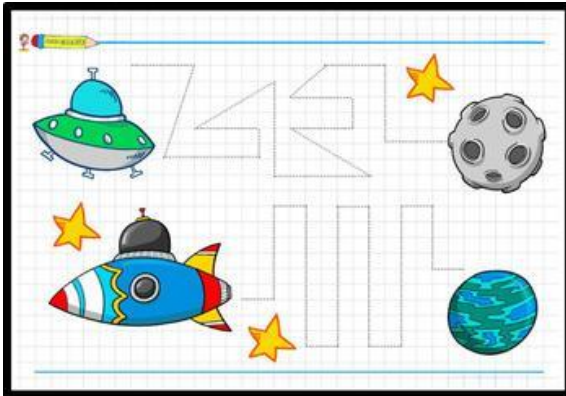


Helping Little Hands Master Big Skills!
