- *sequence or order the letters of the alphabet
- *review the concepts of print (letter, word, sentence, capital, spaces, period)
- *differentiate if two words begin with the same sound
- *listen to and read nonfiction text
- *ask and answer questions from a nonfiction text
- *state the main idea and details from a nonfiction text
- *retell a story in order using character, setting, and events from the story
- *read a familiar text to build fluency
- *read words with the -at rime (bat, cat, fat)
- *read color words
- *heart words: I, am, the, and, can, my, just, like, that, red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, black, gray, pink, brown
- *review handwriting for Mm

Math Learning Goals:

- *recognize, name, and write numbers 0-10
- *see quantities of 10 in a frame quickly
- *count groups of 0-10 with accuracy
- *count to 50 by ones, tens, and fives
- *state what number is one more than or one less than to 10
- *state what number comes before or after up to 10
- *begin to do beginning addition of story problems

<u>Tuesday:</u> Library/Gym/Homework: go on a walk and "spy" things that begin with Ss
