Dear Parent/Guardian,

In accordance with ESEA Section 1111(h)(6) PARENTS RIGHT-TO-KNOW, at the beginning of each school year, a school district that receives funds under this part shall notify the parents of each student attending any school receiving funds under this part that the parents may request. The district will provide the parents on request (and promptly), information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers, including, at a minimum, the following:

- whether the student's teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction
- is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived
- is teaching in the field of the discipline of the certification of the teacher
- whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

In addition to the information stated above, parents of students in schools that receive funds under this part may request

- information on the level of achievement and academic growth of the student, if applicable and available, on each of the State academic assessments required under this part
- timely notice that the student has been assigned, or has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by, a teacher who does not meet applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.

Our staff is committed to helping your child develop the academic knowledge and critical thinking he/she needs to empower them on their pathway to success. That commitment includes ensuring that all our teachers and paraprofessionals are highly skilled.
