A+ Sandridge...

Sandridge Elementary students get four core classes and specials as a part of an educational program to teach the whole child. All students have ELA or English Language Arts. This course focuses on reading, writing, spelling, vocabulary, and comprehension. We use McGraw Hill Wonders curriculum for K-5th grade students. 6th-8th grade students use Study Sync.

All students take part in our k-8 grade math curriculum. We use the i-ready program for math and for our diagnostic testing three times a year. This year we are piloting science curriculum. Students in grades kindergarten-5th grade will participate in Project Lead the Way, an innovative STEM program.

At Sandridge we offer gym, health, music, Project Lead the Way, Spanish, and library. We also have a full-time nurse, speech therapist and social worker and we contract an occupational therapist and psychologist.

This year's goals focus on increasing student growth in reading and math and decreasing our absenteeism/truancy numbers especially in the primary and intermediate grades.
