Student Achievement

We are passionate about providing rigorous, high-quality academic achievement in a diverse and enriching environment.

- ILEARN: Increase by 10% the number of students designated as Approaching, At or Above Proficiency on the annual ILEARN assessment.
Baseline: ELA – 47%, Math – 46%
- 9th Grade on Track: Increase by 5% the number of students designated as “9th Grade on Track.” 10 or more credits (2 in ELA, 2 in math, 2 science or social studies)
Baseline: 80%
- SAT: Increase by 10% the number of students designated as “Approaching or At” proficiency on the annual SAT exam.
Baseline: EBRW = 34%, Math = 9%



Student Achievement – (continued)

We are passionate about providing rigorous, high-quality academic achievement in a diverse and enriching environment.

- Student attendance: Reach 75% or increase by 10% the number of students attending 94% of school days enrolled.
Baseline: 62%
- IREAD3: By June 2026, increase by 10% or reach a proficiency rate of 95% on the IREAD3 assessment.
Baseline: 78%
- WIDA: Increase by 10% the number of students reaching their language proficiency target as measured by the annual WIDA Access assessment.
Baseline: 24%



Finance

We are responsible for 23 facilities and over 2,500 employees.

- The MSD of Lawrence Township School Board will ensure a strong and stable financial outlook by maintaining a cash balance of \$14M in the education fund at the end of each calendar year.
- All taxing funds will maintain a positive balance at the end of the fiscal year.
