## Important:

1. **Chromebook** – With a working Charger, and the Chromebook must be fully functional, with a screen that is intact and working, and a fully functional keyboard.

## Basic Supplies:

2. **Backpack** – Large enough to carry books, supplies, and a lunchbox.
3. **Pencil Case** – To organize pens, pencils, erasers, etc.
4. **2 - 3 packs of Pencils** – At least 2-3 packs of standard #2 pencils.
5. **1 pack of Pens** – Blue, black, and red ink pens.
6. **1 pack of Colored Pencils** – For art projects or notes.
7. **1 pack of Markers** – A pack of broad-tip markers for creative projects.
8. **1 Set of Highlighters** – Set of multiple colors.
9. **2 Eraser** – Both pencil top and large erasers.
10. **Ruler** – A 12-inch ruler (preferably with both metric and imperial measurements).
11. **Sharpener** – With a container for shavings.

## Notebooks & Paper:

1. **4 Composition Notebooks** – for journals or writing assignments.
2. **Loose Leaf Paper** – A pack of college-ruled paper.

## Folders & Binders:

1. **Plastic Folders** – For keeping homework and assignments organized.

## Art Supplies:

1. **2 Glue Sticks** – or liquid glue for projects.
2. **Scissors** – Child-safe, pointy scissors.
3. **Crayons** – A basic box of crayons (some schools require this).
4. **Construction Paper** – Various colors for projects.
5. **Play-Doh or Modeling Clay** – Sometimes requested for Science projects. (Science)

## Other Essential Supplies:

1. **Sticky Notes** – For reminders or quick notes.
2. **Index Cards** – For studying or making flashcards.
3. **Wired Headphones/Earbuds** – For computer or tablet-based learning.

## Personal Items:

1. **Plastic Water Bottle** – Reusable, to stay hydrated throughout the day.
2. **Book** – Age appropriate, for reading during free periods or at home.

## Special Items:

1. **Post-it Flags** – For marking important pages.
2. **Locks for School Locker** – School has lockers, a small shelf or tray could be helpful.
