



SACRED HEART SCHOOL UNIFORM/DRESS CODE

OUTERWEAR

Required for Dress Uniform worn to church gatherings, assemblies, and on field trips

All Grades	SHS logo required: Navy blue uniform sweatshirt, fleece jacket, active performance jacket, quarter-zip pullover fleece, or half-zip pullover fleece SHS logo not required: Evergreen V-neck vest, pullover, or cardigan sweater
Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>Outerwear must be purchased from one of our uniform providers</i> ➤ <i>Logos required except on sweaters</i> ➤ <i>All outerwear must be marked with the student's name</i> ➤ <i>Non-uniform sweatshirts or jackets may only be worn during lunch and recess</i> ➤ <i>Sacred Heart CYO, 8th Grade Class, D.C. Trip, SHS Club, or Student Council sweatshirts may be worn as part of the uniform, with the exception of Mass days; on Mass days, regular uniform outerwear (sweaters or SHS logo sweatshirts) is required</i>

TOPS

All Grades	Polos: Long or short sleeved white, navy, or dark green Additional girls options: White turtleneck may be worn under jumpers Long or short sleeved white blouse (Peter Pan, Oxford, Fem Fit, or No Gape)
Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>No logos</i> ➤ <i>Undershirts must be solid white and only visible at the collar</i> ➤ <i>The dark green polo will be removed from the uniform after the 2025-2026 school year</i>

BOTTOMS

K-5 Boys	Navy Pants and Khaki Shorts
K-5 Girls	Navy Pants and Khaki Shorts Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid Jumper Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid Pleated Skort Top of the Knee Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid Box Pleat Skirt Top of the Knee
6-8 Boys	Khaki Pants or Shorts
6-8 Girls	Khaki Plain Front Chino Pants or Shorts Khaki Skort Top of the Knee Khaki Box Pleat Skirt Top of the Knee
Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Shorts, jumpers, skirts, and skorts are to be no more than three (3) inches above the knee ➤ <i>Cargo pants and pants with extra pockets are not allowed</i> ➤ <i>Leggings may not be worn as pants in any grade</i> ➤ <i>All skirts and skorts must be purchased from Lands' End or Tommy Hilfiger; skirts and skorts from outside vendors are not allowed</i> ➤ <i>Shorts or solid white, navy blue, black, or dark green leggings or tights must be worn under skirts and jumpers (Girls' Navy Bike Shorts available at Lands' End are one option)</i>

SOCKS AND SHOES

K-5	Solid white, navy blue, black, or dark green socks (boys/girls), leggings or tights (girls). Socks with <i>small</i> logos are allowed.
6-8	Socks may be any color, as long as they are not distracting. On school Mass/Assembly days: <u>solid</u> white, navy blue, black, or dark green socks (boys/girls), tights or leggings (girls) are required. Socks with <i>small</i> logos are allowed. No other logos allowed.
Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>Shoes and socks must be worn at all times and shoelaces must be kept tied</i> ➤ <i>Shoes must be closed-toed, attach to the heel, and fit snugly (slippers are not allowed)</i> ➤ <i>Shoes with wheels or lights are not allowed</i> ➤ <i>All students in K-8 must wear athletic shoes on PE days</i> ➤ <i>Crocs with back strap may only be worn on free dress and spartan wear days</i>

Hair, Headwear, and Hair Accessories

- Extreme hair styles (mohawks, shaved, spiked, designs, or logos) and unnatural colors (dyed or streaked) are not allowed.
- Boys' hair must be above the collar and out of the eyes. Boys may not have facial hair.
- Hair accessories, including elastics, must be white, dark green, navy blue, black, or uniform plaid to coordinate with uniform colors. Headbands or accessories should not have distracting decorations.
- **Middle school girls** may wear any color hair accessories on regular school days, as long as they are not distracting. *On Mass days*, all hair accessories must be white, dark green, navy blue, black, or uniform plaid.

Jewelry, Cosmetics, & Belts

- No makeup, other than light concealer or cover-up.
- Nail polish is not allowed for students in grades K-5. Nail polish is allowed for girls in grades 6-8. Nails must be kept neat and clean with no chipped polish. No acrylic nails are allowed.
- No tattoos or henna tattoos are allowed.
- Girls may wear stud earrings only in the ear lobe. Boys may not wear earrings.
- Boys and girls may wear only one bracelet on each wrist. Necklaces are allowed.
- Students may wear black or brown belts.

Non-Uniform Days

Free Dress Days

- All shorts, skirts, dresses, and skorts **must meet the length requirements** of the regular school uniform.
- Torn jeans, cut-offs, tank tops, halter tops, crop tops, spaghetti straps, and low necklines are not allowed.
- **Leggings/yoga pants are not allowed as pants** but may be worn under shorts, pants, dresses, or skirts.
- Basketball shorts, sweatpants, and joggers in good repair are allowed.
- Costumes may be worn only on days with specific themes (e.g., Disney Day, Super-hero Day).
- "Onesies" may only be worn when they are part of a theme day free dress.
- Students who choose not to participate in free dress or theme days must wear their regular school uniform.

Spartan Wear Days

- Once a month, per the [Free Dress & Spartan Wear Calendar](#), students are allowed to wear Spartan Wear.
- Students may only wear Sacred Heart logo tops: sweatshirts, t-shirts, pullovers, jerseys, or polo shirts.
- Students must wear a uniform shirt under spirit outerwear if they do not have a Sacred Heart logo t-shirt underneath.
- Students **may wear uniform or free-dress pants, shorts, or skirts along with Spartan Wear tops.**

Other

- Uniforms are to be clean, correctly sized, in good repair, and appropriately worn.
- All clothing and accessories must be safe, not distracting to the learning environment, and school appropriate.
- Scout uniforms may be worn on meeting days.
- Unmarked lost and found uniform items are turned over to the Parents' Club used uniform program to be re-sold as a fundraiser for the school.
- If a student is out of uniform for a medical reason, a note/email with a satisfactory explanation (signed by a parent/guardian) is required indicating the number of days the student will be out of uniform.

Uniform Policy Non-Compliance

If students in Pre-K through 3rd grade are out of uniform, emails will be sent home. Ongoing issues will result in a meeting between parents and school administration.

Any student in 4th-8th grade not in compliance with the Uniform Policy, including inappropriate attire on non-uniform or theme days, will be subject to the following consequences:

- 1st Offense: Uniform Notice sent home (must be signed and returned w/in 2 school days or recess detention will be assigned)
- 2nd Offense: Uniform Notice sent home (must be signed and returned w/in 2 school days or recess detention will be assigned)
- 3rd Offense: Temporary loss of Free Dress and/or Spartan Wear privileges
- 4th Offense: After school detention
- 5th Offense: Non-admittance to class and student sent home

The administration reserves the right to go immediately to step 5 if a student's clothing/hair is extremely out of line and inappropriate for a Catholic school environment.
