About The Teacher: Hello! My name is Melissa Daniels, and this is my 25th year as a teacher, 12 of which have been spent at Springdale as a grades sixth-eighth ELA teacher. I am looking forward to teaching your student this year. I welcome your cooperation in your child's education. I am available via email and the Remind app for any questions or concerns you may have or by phone during my daily planning time.

Class Materials:For ELA class, students will need the following materials:

- 2-3" binder with 7 tab dividers and notebook paper
- 2-pocket folder
- Pencils
- Highlighters
- Index Cards
- Sticky notes
- Novels and Reading workbooks (provided for the students)

Classroom Rules:

- Students should come to class prepared to learn with the materials required.
- Students should be respectful of their classmates and teacher.
- Students should display a positive attitude toward learning.
- Students should participate actively in class, which includes discussions and learning activities.
- Students should follow all school rules and classroom procedures.

Classroom Procedures: Students will enter the classroom with materials needed and ready to learn. Students will complete a daily warm-up and all English/Language Arts activities for the day. Students will use Language binders to keep daily warm-ups, vocabulary, notes, handouts, classwork, etc. in. Students will receive one progress report halfway through the nine-weeks grading period and one report card per nine-weeks. Parents may check Aspen to see student grades throughout the nine-weeks grading period.

Food:Per school rules, students may only have water in the classroom. No other food or drinks are allowed.

Cheating/Plagiarism: Neither cheating nor plagiarism is tolerated in my classroom. Students caught cheating or plagiarising work are subject to a grade of zero on that assignment.

Absence: Should a student miss a day of school, he or she is responsible for asking me for missed assignments. Students are given one day per day of absence to turn in work missed. Should a student miss a test or quiz, he/she should make that up in a timely manner upon return.

Grading: Students are graded on novel assessments, quizzes, daily work assignments, binder checks, and projects in ELA class. Grades are not weighted.

Extra Credit: I give extra-credit opportunities once during a nine-week grading period. I typically pass extra credit opportunities out the week after progress reports go out. Students typically have two-three weeks to complete and turn in extra credit opportunities should he/she choose to do so. Students may choose up to three extra credit opportunities from the list I give.

Homework: I do not give homework routinely. Students may have homework if they do not complete an assignment during class time. Every other Friday, students will have a Vocabulary Word Bag quiz for which they should study at home.

Curriculum: 7th grade Wit and Wisdom ELA curriculum is used in my classroom. All reading, writing, and English standards are taught through this curriculum.
