



Tardy Sweeps

Report immediately to the commos for tardy sweep

Scan in to tardy sweep

Get your pass

Go directly to class. Do not stop to socialize, with anyone, go to the restroom or anything

Give your pass to your teacher

Attendance

Come to school!!! You miss out when you are not at school.

8 - 9 absences = lose credit (does not matter if you brought a note)

Skipping

Skipping class will not be tolerated!

Having a pass does not excuse you from skipping. Return to class promptly.

Be sure to have a pass and be in your assigned area

Refusal to go to tardy sweep or return to class in a timely manner will result in consequences from your AP

Tardy and absences will cause you to lose exemptions for final exams.

3 absences and/or 3 tardies = loss of exemption

Upstairs = red area

Downstairs = silver area

Portables = gold

NURSE


Must have permission from the nurse to be in there.

TAKING CARE OF YOUR CHROMEBOOK

General

- You are responsible for the care of the Chromebooks.
- Chromebooks should never be taken to an outside computer service for repairs.
 - Keep food and drinks away.
- Insert cords, cables, and removable storage devices carefully.
- Avoid exposing
 Chromebooks to extreme temperatures, such as leaving them in a car.
 - Keep Chromebooks free of writing, drawings, or stickers.

Carrying/Screen Care

- Always hold Chromebooks with care and never lift Chromebooks by the screen.
- Never carry Chromebooks with the screen open.
- Do not apply/add pressure to the top of a closed Chromebook.
- Before closing the lid, ensure nothing is on the keyboard(e.g., pens, pencils, notebooks, etc).
- Clean the screen only with a soft, dry microfiber or anti-static cloth.

Battery/Updates

POXPY

- Charge your Chromebook regularly to ensure it is ready for use when needed.
- Avoid letting the battery drain completely.
- Unplug your Chromebook after it has reached 100%.
- Keep your Chromebook's software up to date by regularly bringing your device to school.
- Report any software issues by creating an LTEC ticket.
- Do not try to install unauthorized software or applications on the Chromebook.



TAKING CARE OF YOUR CHROMEBOOK

Security

- Never share your Chromebook password or login information with others.
- Report any suspicious activity or security concerns to the school immediately.

- If lost, report immediately by submitting a ticket.
- If stolen, submit a ticket along with a police report.

Fees/Fines

 Chromebooks that are found to be intentionally damaged will result in a fee that will be assessed to the student through School Cash.

Additional Information



- The Chromebook is CFISD property and issued to students for educational purposes.
- The Chromebook is for temporary use until graduation or withdrawal.
- If students leave the school they attend or CFISD, the device must be returned to the campus immediately or a fee will be assessed in School Cash.


This training includes discussions and images around such topics as violence, bullying, suicide, and self-harm.

However, schools are not immune to violence and threats.






People often show warning signs before they hurt themselves or others.

- Being obsessed with weapons or school shootings.
- Talking about hurting people.
- Talking or posting about an upcoming attack.
- Bringing a weapon to school.

- Big changes in personality or appearance.
- Withdrawal from friends and activities.
- Refusing to go to school.
- Being physically or verbally abused.
- Cruelty to animals.
- Being bullied or bullying others.




What is a Threat?


When someone communicates that they **PLAN TO HARM** others.

"THEY WILL REGRET THEY EVER MET ME."








Social Media is a main source of warning signs and threats.
