**LESBIAN, GAY, BISEXUAL, TRANSGENDER, and QUEER (LGBTQ+) PRIDE MONTH
JUNE 1 – JUNE 30, 2024**

WHEREAS, "Gay and Lesbian Pride Month" was established in June of 2000 by Presidential Proclamation and grew to eventually be designated **Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer (LGBTQ+) Pride Month**; and

WHEREAS, this month was chosen as it denotes the anniversary of the protests against unfair discrimination and harassment following a June 1969 police raid on the Stonewall Inn, a gay bar in New York City. This event was considered a watershed moment in the modern LGBTQ+ rights movement in the United States, earning national attention in their struggle for equality; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQ+ Pride Month is a time to take a positive stance against offensive and violent behavior toward LGBTQ+ people, demonstrate acceptance, peacefully protest, and raise political awareness of current issues facing their community, encourage inclusiveness, and promote their diversity, dignity, and visibility as a social group; and


WHEREAS, the LGBTQ+ community is working to create more safe spaces, especially in schools by empowering LGBT youth to speak out against bullying and actively participate in GSA club leadership sessions to engender support and build community; and


WHEREAS, California Education Code Section 51204.5 specifically calls for instruction in the social sciences to include the study of the role and contributions of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender Americans, to the economic, political, and social development of California and the nation, with particular emphasis on portraying the role of this group in contemporary society; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the South San Francisco Unified School District Board of Trustees hereby recognizes and wishes to honor LGBTQ+ Americans during **LGBTQ+ Pride Month**.







