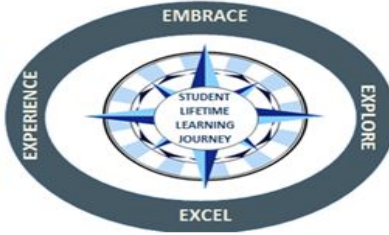

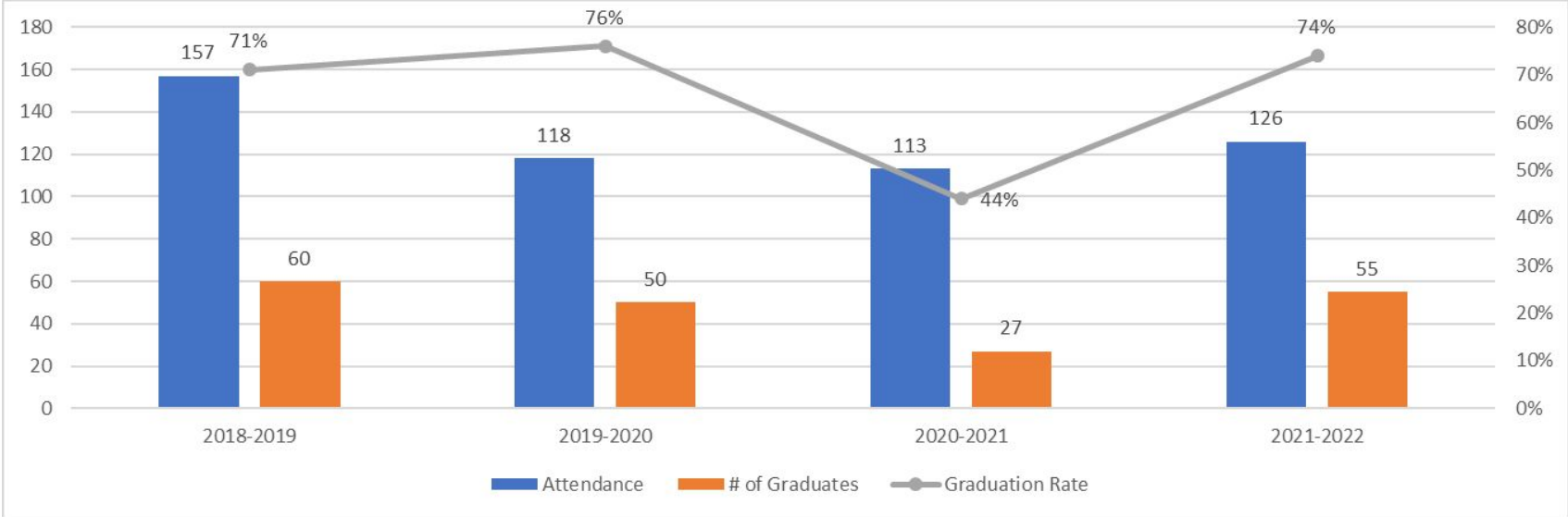
The results of COVID

- Many students suffering from Social-emotional trauma

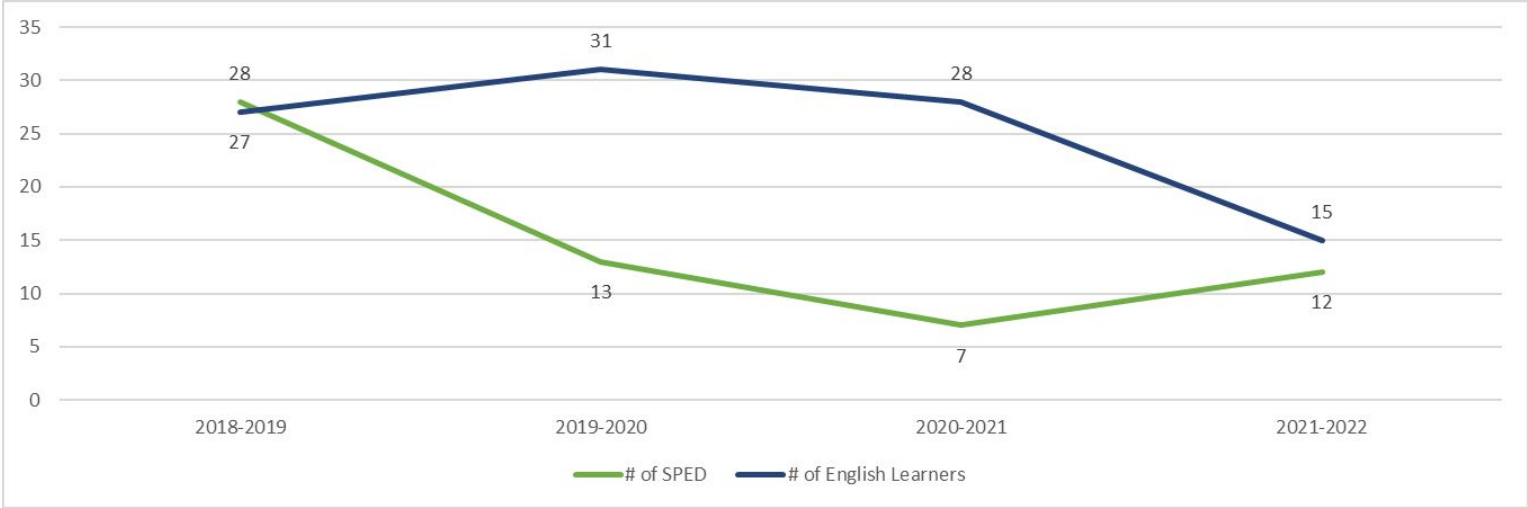
How have we adjusted

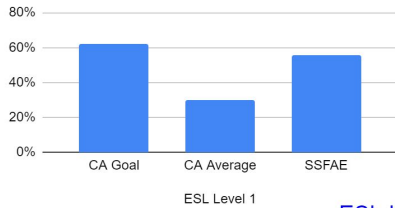
What have we learned over the last two years

- Our student enrollment dropped from 1009 to 619 due to the pandemic.
- There is a need for more Career Technical Education programs in SSF
- Our partners who want to collaborate are growing
- Students drop our EL classes before they has mastered English proficiency

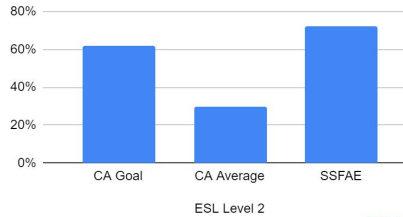
ESL CASAS Assessment Data

- Implemented the district's data analysis protocol into the ESL department
- Teachers in each of the 5 levels engaged the process and implemented strategies guided by the data reports from their level
- All 5 ESL levels exceeded the CA State Average
- 3 ESL levels exceeded the CA State Goal
- *CASAS - Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment System

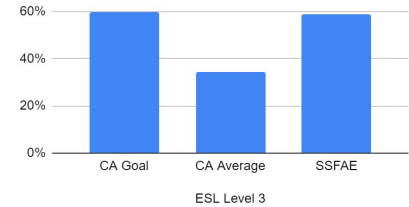

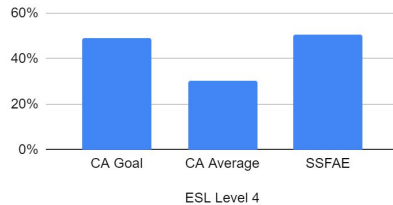
ESL Level 2



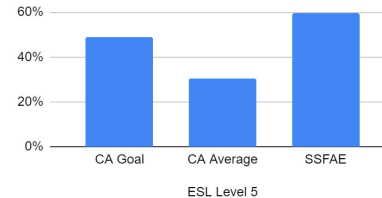
