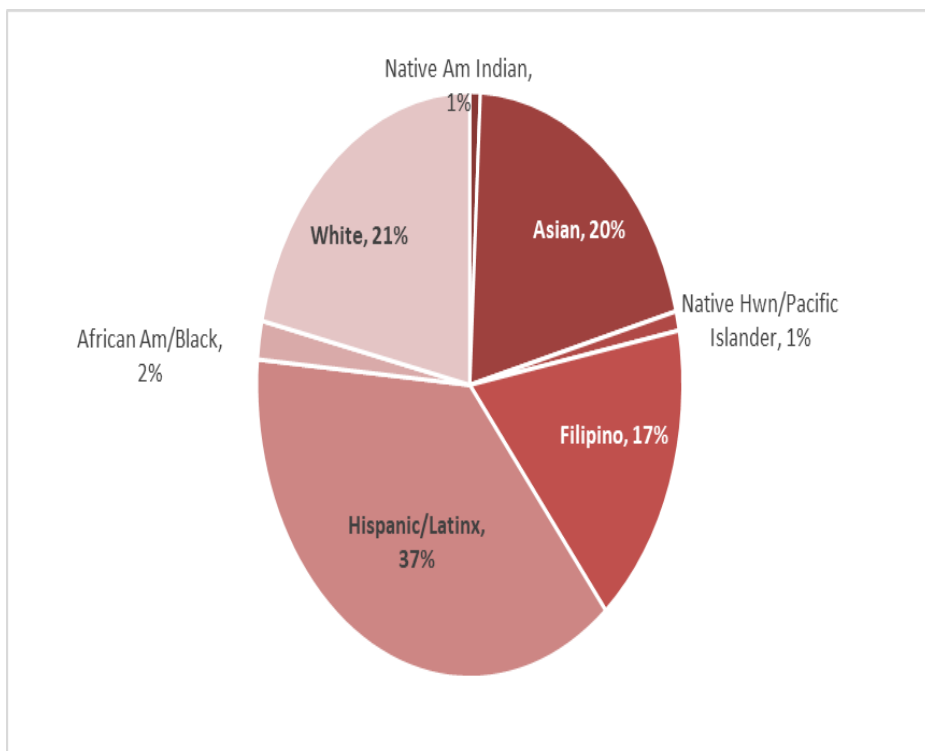

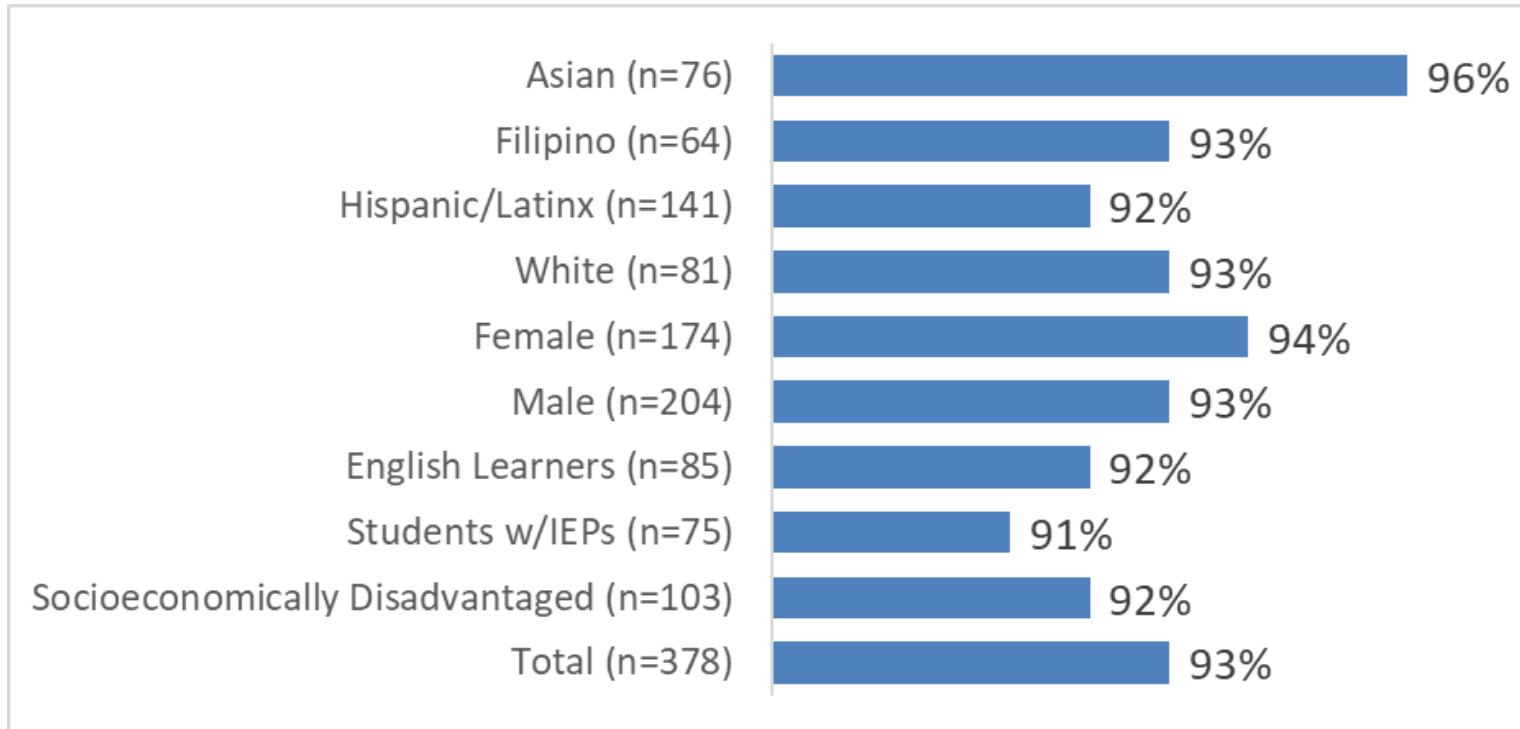

Ponderosa Elementary - attendance snapshot

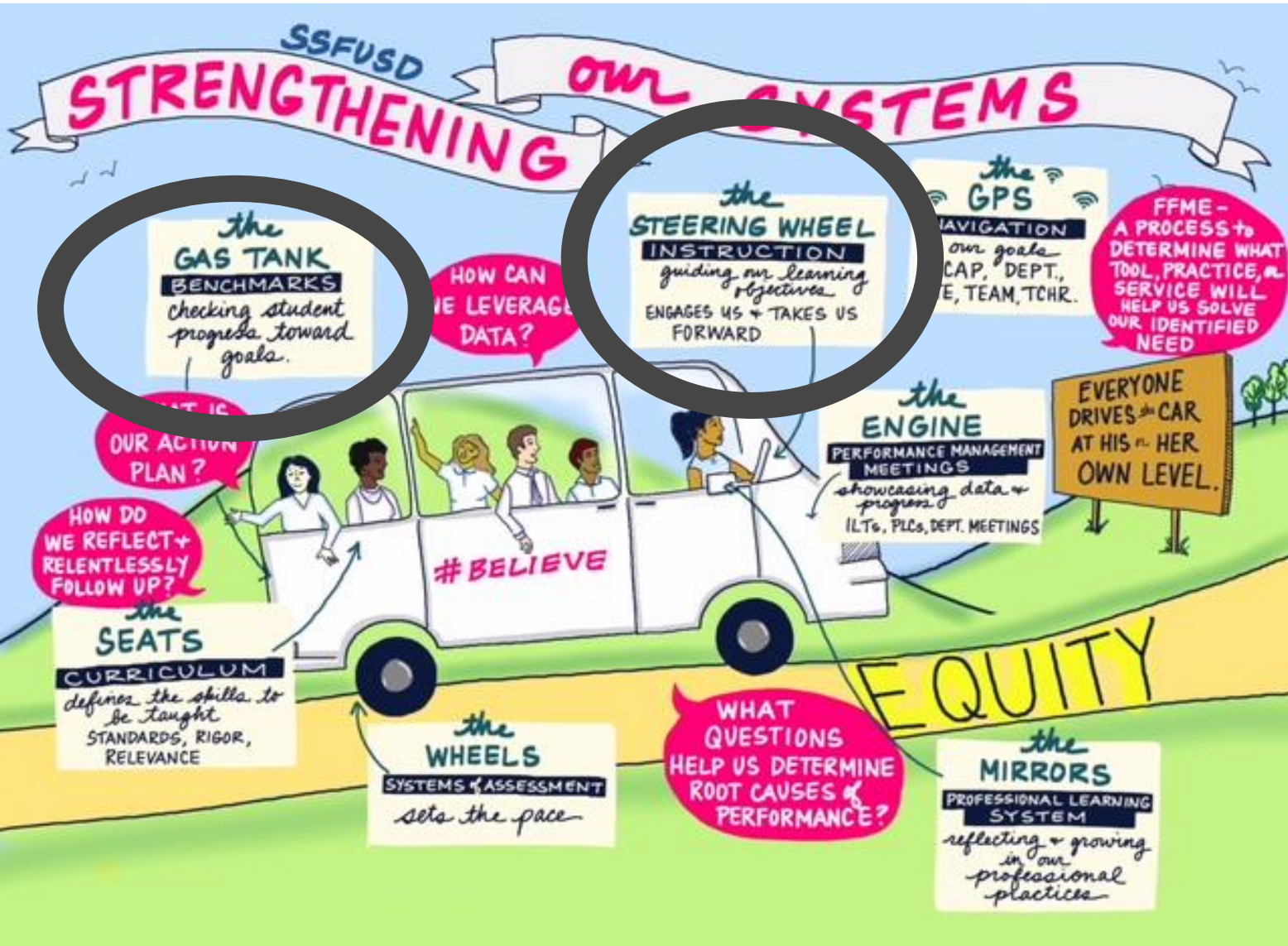
Average attendance by cohort group: 10/18 - 11/23
