Comments:

Currently, we are in the middle of another spike. It was extremely irresponsible and dangerous for the schools to open prior to testing everyone (including staff) before returning to campus. We are now seeing schools across the country understaffed because teachers are sick. I do not understand why or safety or well being is not being taken into account. We are treated like robots, like we are not putting ourselves at risk. I am curious as to why the district has not provided us with proper masks (N-95s) when we are expected to be crammed into a room with 30 plus students. Some students have to be reminded multiple times to put their masks over their noses and mouths, and nothing happened. I recall the MOU stating that if students "refused" to wear masks that they would be sent home. Where is that protocol for these students who have to be reminded all day in order to comply? I asked a district staff member and was told that they are only for medical personnel and if I felt apprehensive, I could purchase my own. It's like we are being put up for sacrifice. No one cares about teachers and it has been made very clear. There is already a teacher shortage nationwide, and the district is choosing to ignore this by not taking teacher health and needs into account. Please consider remote options for teachers or students who are scared, or ensure that students/staff that are ill are not on campus, regardless of vaccination status. Is an open school worth the lives of teachers and students?

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
