

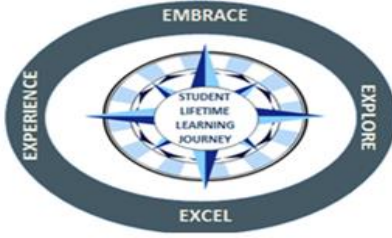

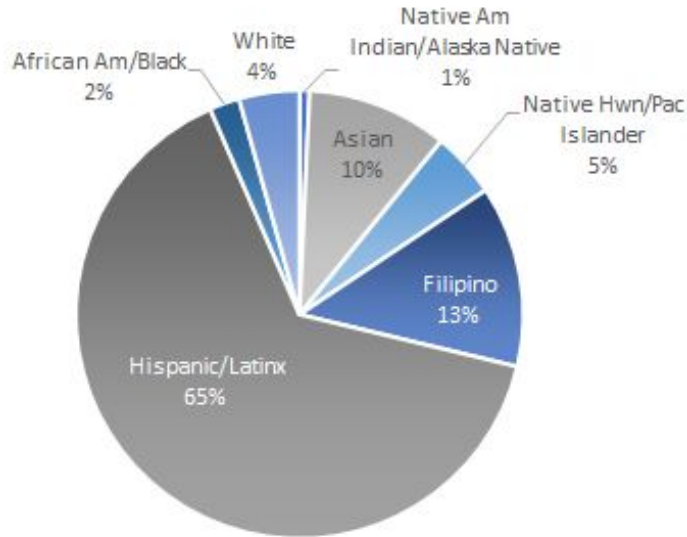

As of November 1, 11 students in Virtual Independent Study

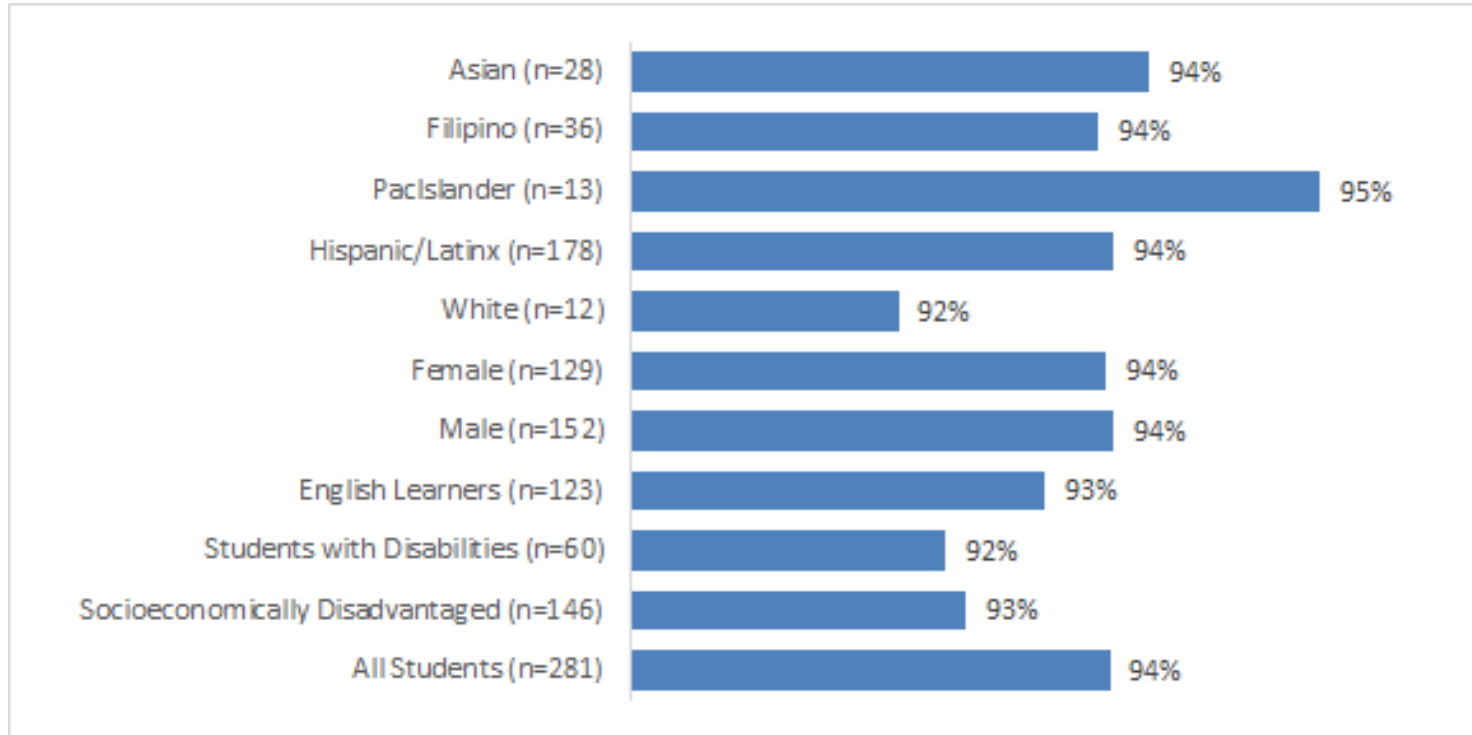

English Language Arts Goal for 2021-22

30% of students, gr 3-5 meet or exceed on SBAC

- Gr 2-5 increase Literably scores from 45% to 55%
- Gr 1 increase F&P scores from C to H
- Work with teachers--good 1st Teaching
- Gr K-2 students have phonemic awareness, phonics and reading groups, 4x/wk
- PE/Socio-emotional classes 4x/wk; teachers prep/plan

Math Goal for 2021-22

21% of students, grades 3-5 will meet or exceed in SBAC

- 3rd grade increase IxL math scores from 245 to 345
- 4th grade increase IxL math scores from 288 to 388
- 5th grade increase IxL math scores from 346 to 400
- Work with teachers--good 1st Teaching
- Gr 3-5 students have math intervention classes 4x/wk
- PE/Socio-emotional classes 4x/wk; teachers prep/plan
