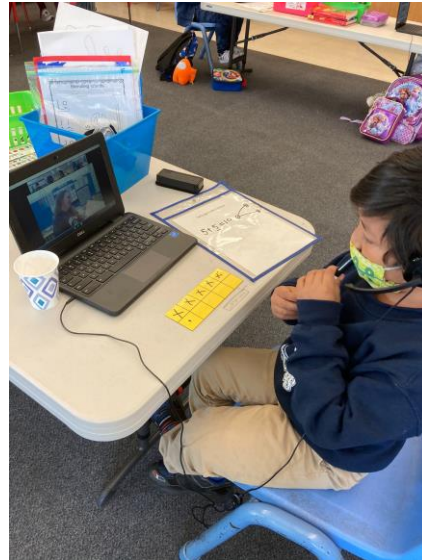


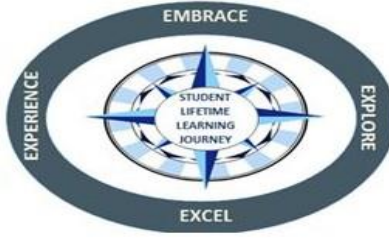

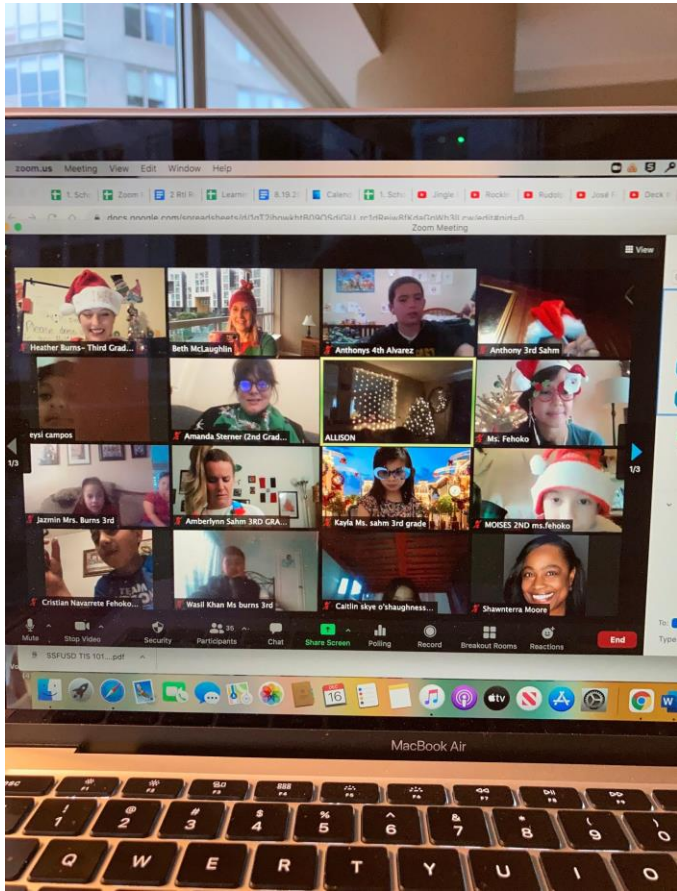

Action plan for Intervention

Last year, Kinder and 1st graders had small group instruction in reading.

This year it has been expanded K-2 and in last month includes 3rd grade.

Due to problematic phonemic awareness issues in grades K-2, Los Cerritos purchased materials and provided extensive training for teachers and now students are getting explicit instructions in how words work.

Attendance--improved by 1% from Dec 2020 to Feb 2021

- ★ Opened 3 learning hubs on January 11, 2021
- ★ Continued one (REAL program)
- ★ Top 40 chronic attendance students:
 - 17 put into learning hubs
 - 5 special education
 - 18 family deaths, COVID health issues, and more
