As a concerned parent who wants the best for her child through this unprecedented time, the packet I received from Spruce Elementary School regarding the details for distance learning did not provide the answers I need to prepare my child for the first day of school, plus the information was not clear and caused so much confusion. The packet provided me with the login and password to the portal, but no reference to where the portal was located. After finding out from calling the school where the portal was located, the login I was provided didn't work. The school later called me back that the login was not set up yet by the SSFUSD's IT department yet and to test it again either Thursday or Friday. There was no mention in the packet that logins and passwords to the portal will be created at a specific time. It is assumed that when parents receive the login and password, the login and password should have already been set up so parents can test it out.

Anyways, I tested it again today and it worked, but I still have no information as to how my child's classes will be organized and whether it will be through Zoom, Skype, etc. not do I have the link to attend the classroom. I even emailed my child's teacher for answers to the questions I have and she has not replied back to my email.

I should not be feeling this unprepared a few days before my child's first day of school. I understand that this is new to everyone, but it is the school's responsibility to better prepare themselves and to provide clear and concise information to the parents so there is no confusion or miscommunication.

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
