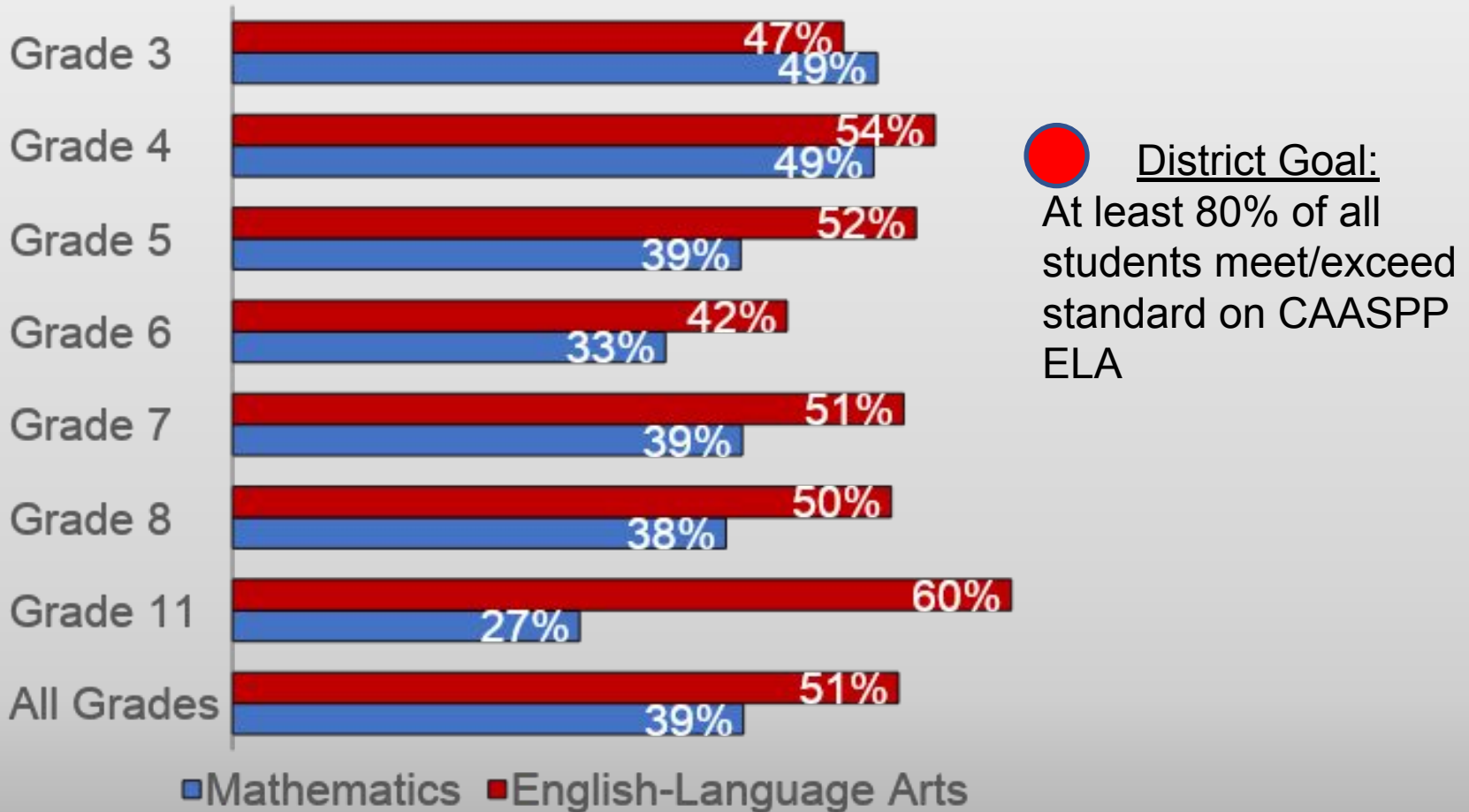

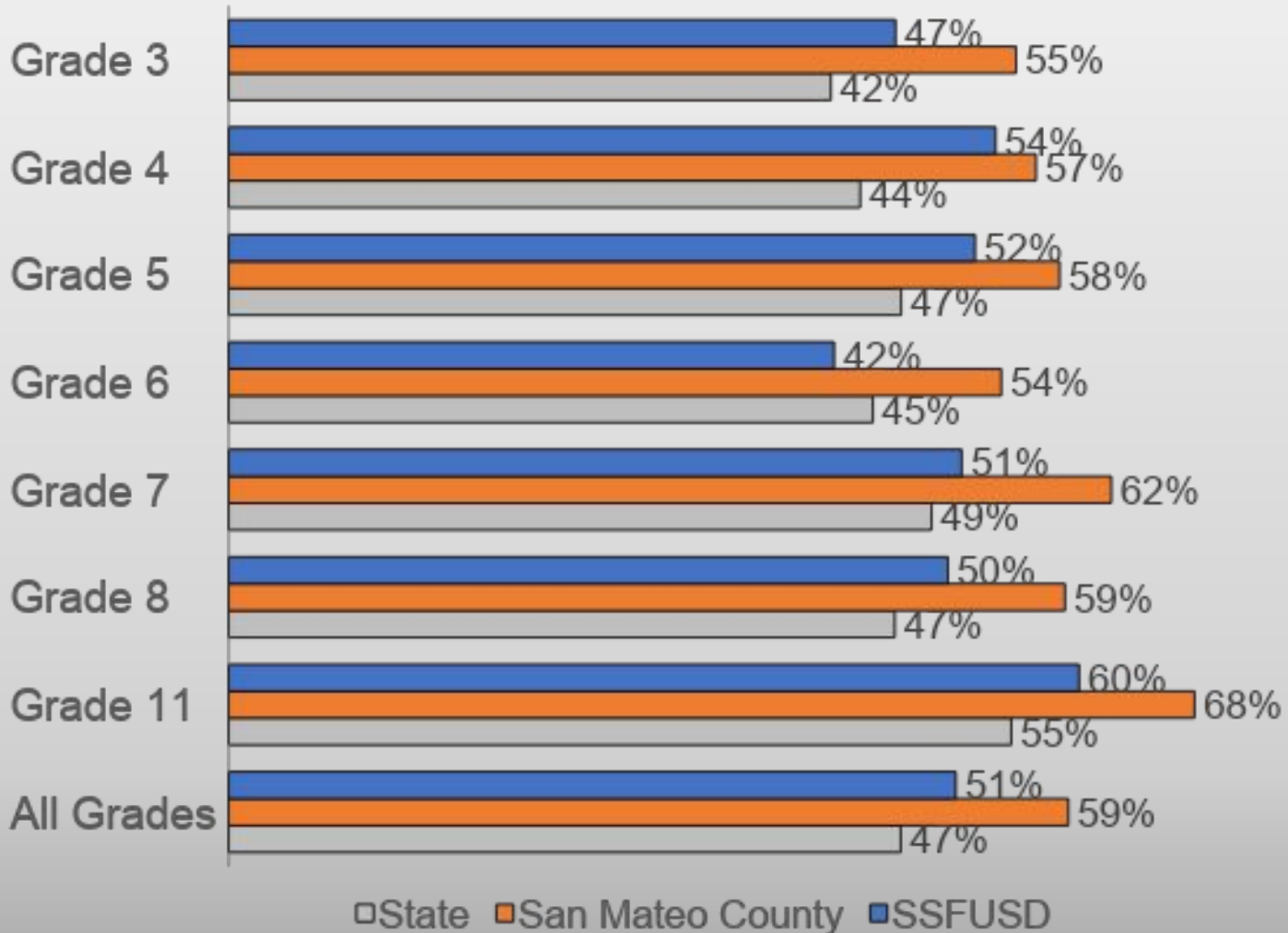
Students Meeting/Exceeding Standard - by Grade Level





# Smarter Balanced English-Language Arts: SSFUSD, County, State

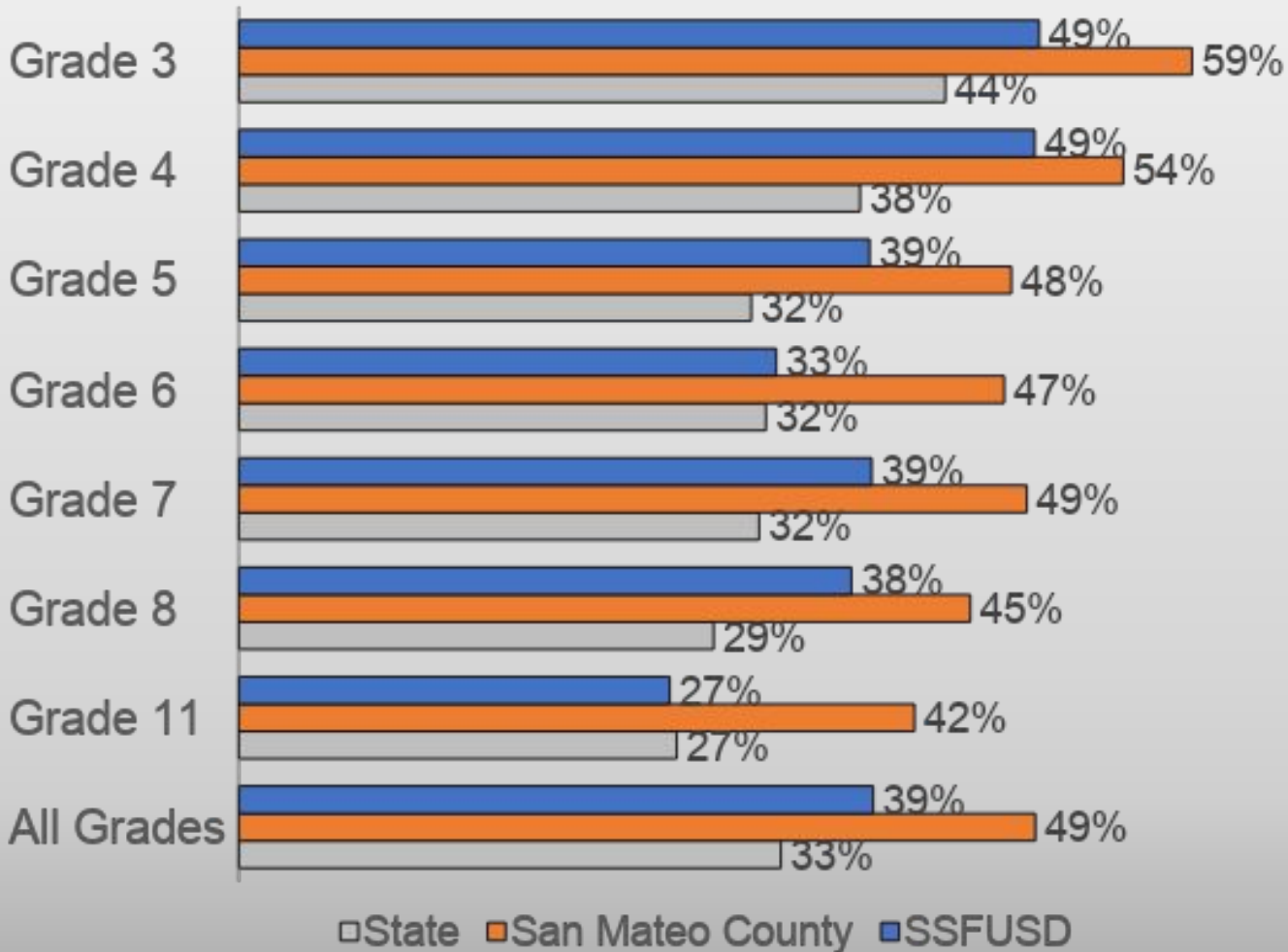
Percentage of Students Meeting/Exceeding Standard - by Grade Level





# Smarter Balanced Mathematics: SSFUSD, County, State

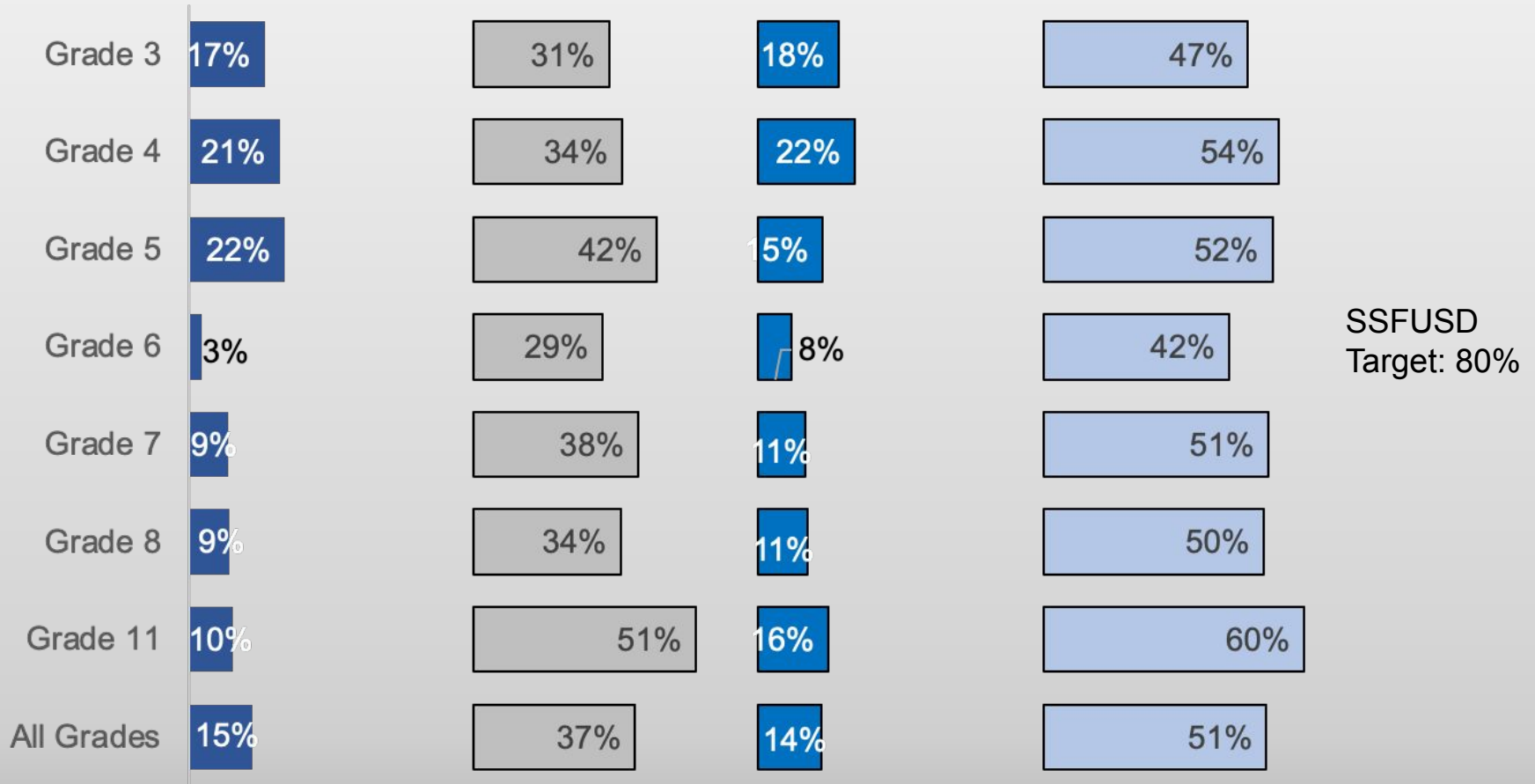
Percentage of Students Meeting/Exceeding Standard - by Grade Level

Percentage of Students Meeting/Exceeding Standard - by Grade Level

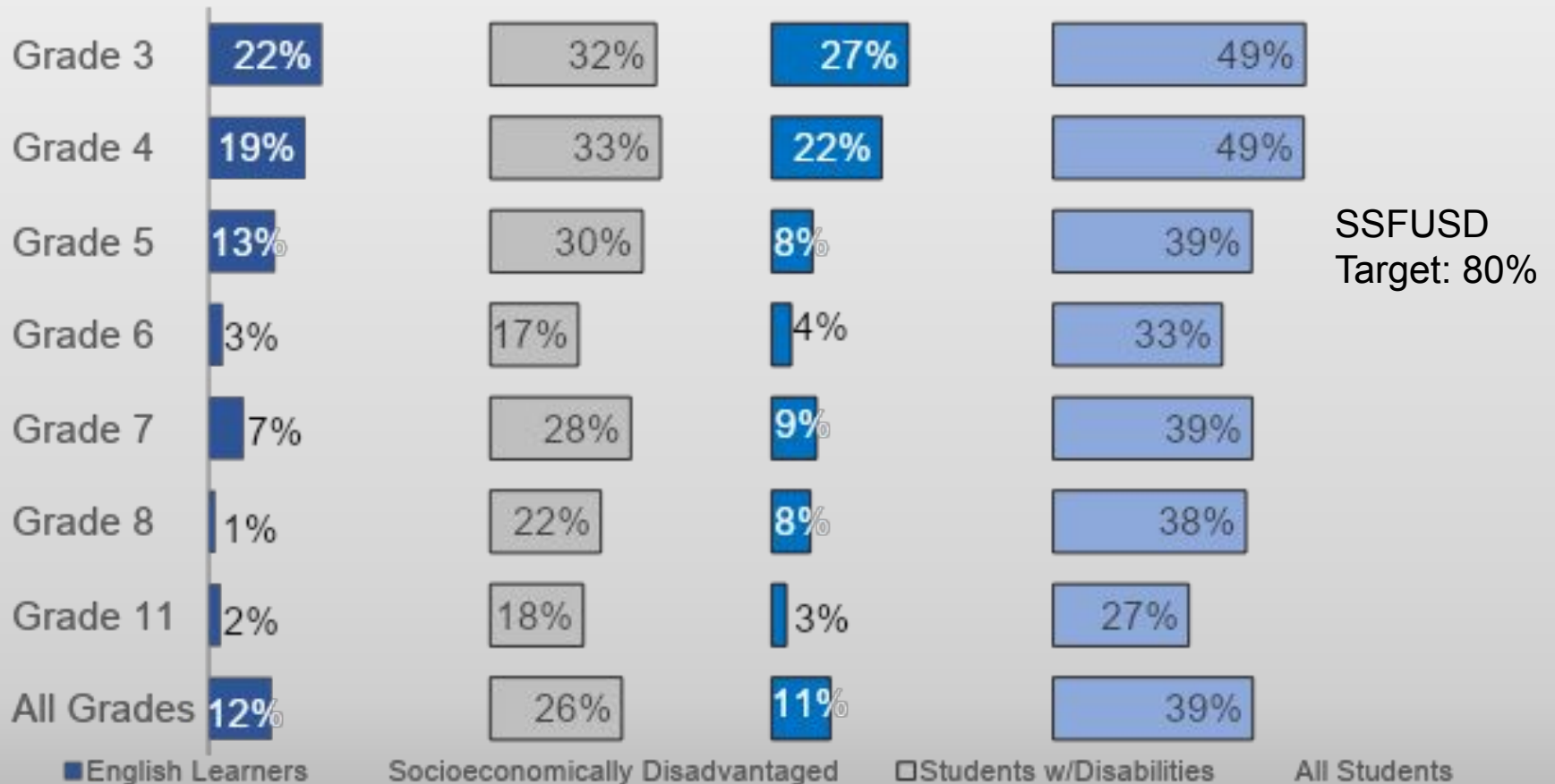

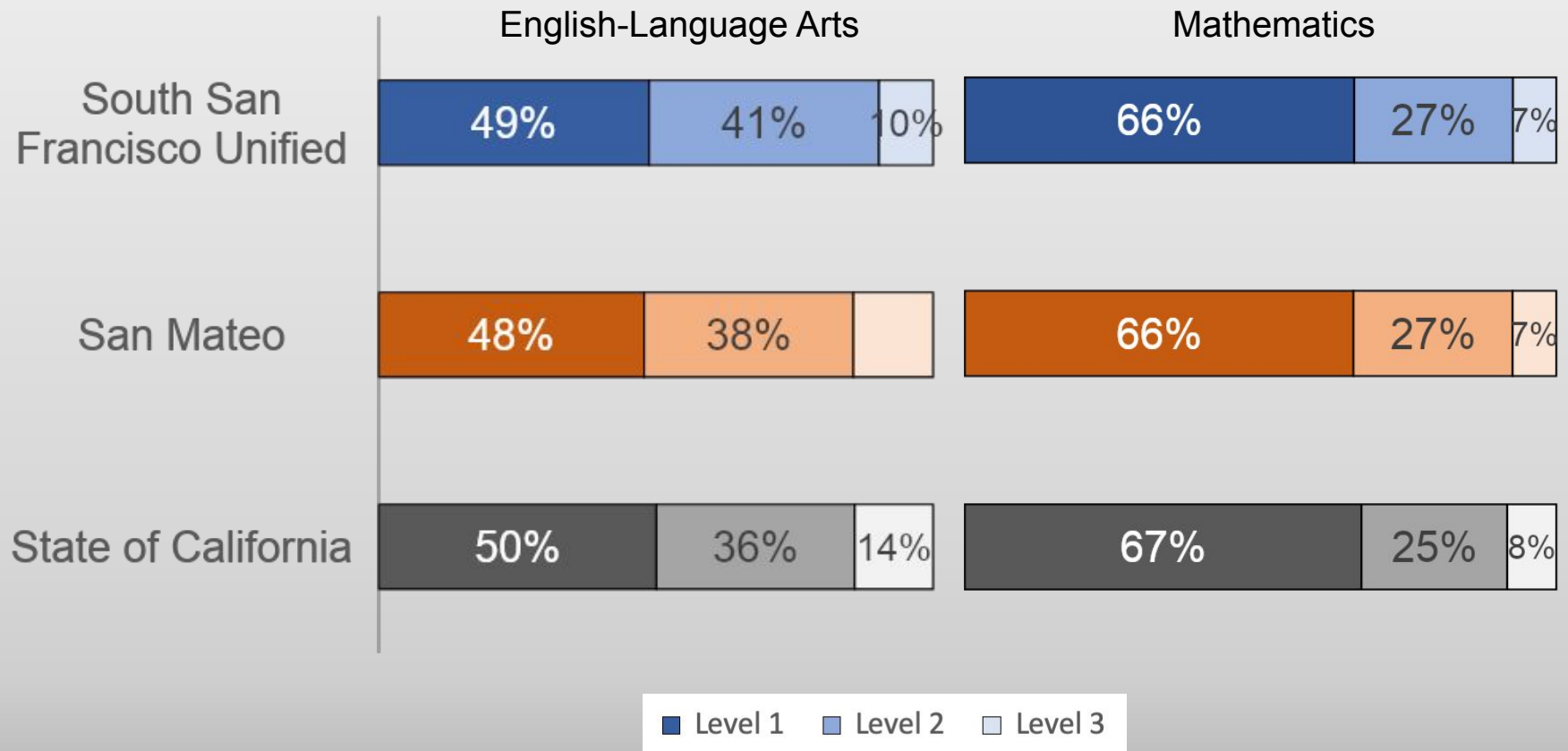
Percentage of Students Meeting/Exceeding Standard - by Grade Level

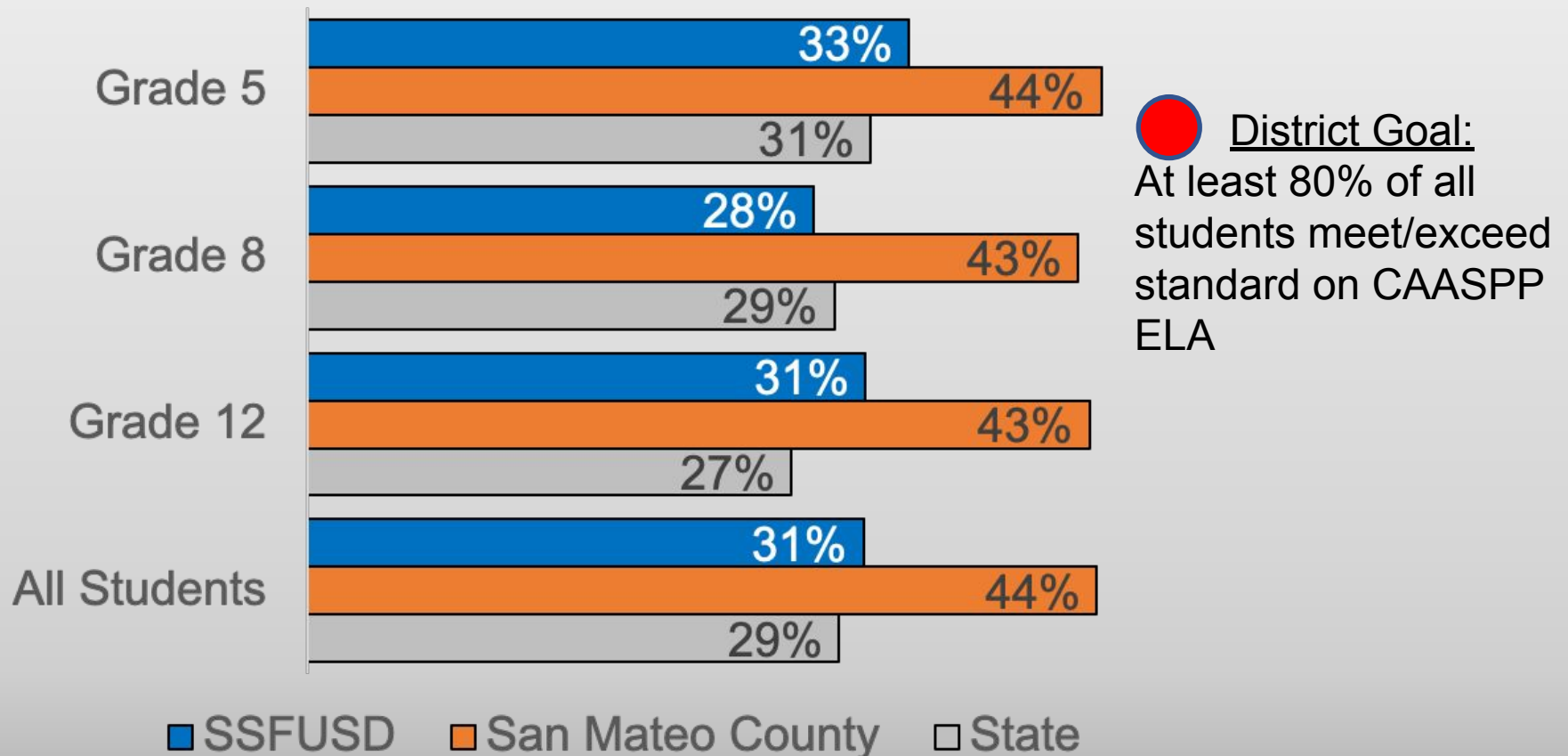
## All Students by Performance Level

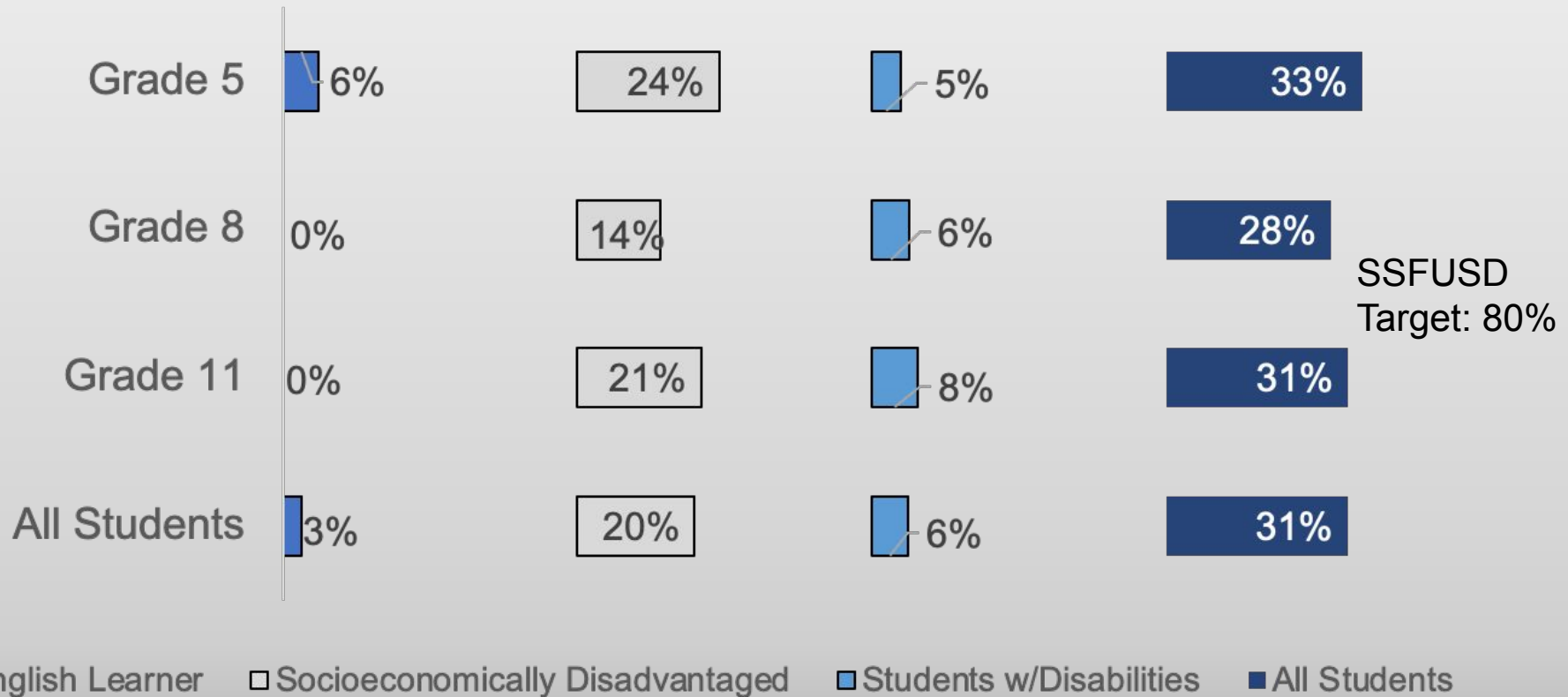
Percentage of Students Meeting/Exceeding Standard - by Grade Level

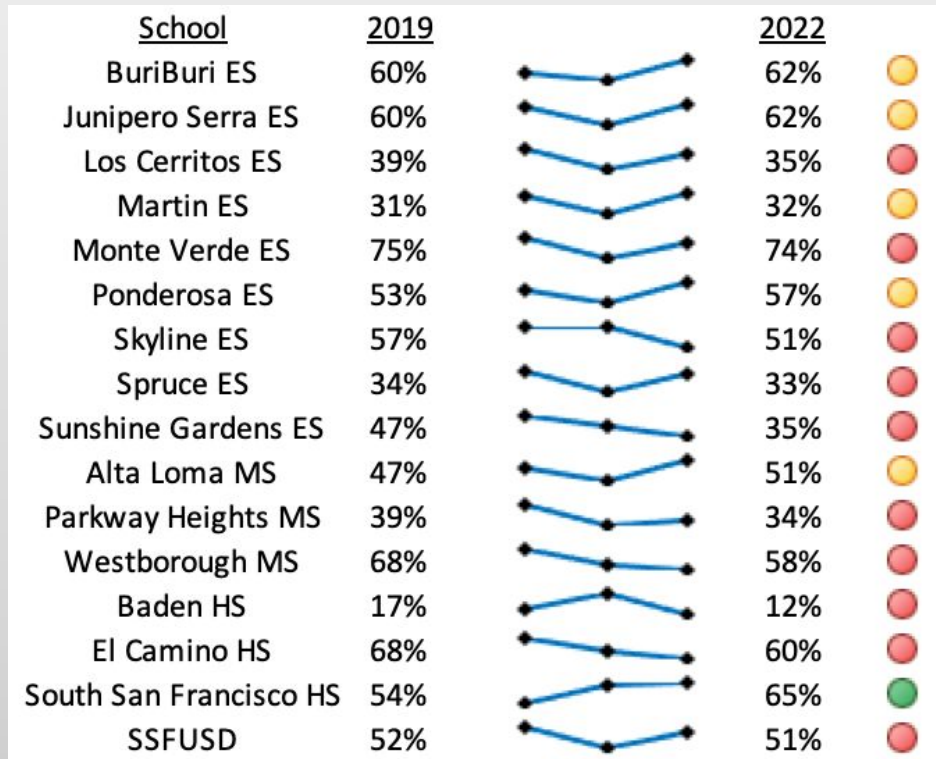
- Progress from 2021 to 2022:
- 7 schools improved by more than 5 percentage points
  - 4 schools maintained
  - 5 schools declined
  - Socioeconomically Disadvantaged student group improved by more than 5 percentage points
  - English Learner and Students w/Disabilities group maintained

# Progress in English-Language Arts (2019 - 2022)

- From 2019 to 2022:
- 1 school improved by more than 5 percentage points
  - 5 schools returned to pre-pandemic levels
  - 10 schools declined
  - Target student groups improved from 2021 to 2022; Socioeconomically Disadvantaged group returned to pre-pandemic levels

*Note: In 2021, due to distance learning and remote testing, participation rates in SSFUSD were below the target 95%, ranging from 29% to 96%*

## From 2021 to 2022:

- 7 schools improved by more than 5 percentage points
- 3 schools maintained
- 6 schools declined
- Target student groups maintained

## From 2019 to 2022:

- 1 school improved by more than 5 percentage points
- 2 schools returned to pre-pandemic levels
- 13 schools declined
- Target student groups improved from 2021 to 2022 but remain below 2019 levels

From 2019 to 2022:

- Declined in Smarter Balanced ELA and Mathematics
- Declined in CAST
- Declined in CA Alternate ELA and Mathematics

*Note: In 2021, due to distance learning and remote testing, participation rates in SSFUSD were below the target 95%, ranging from 29% to 96%. Because the CA Alternate Assessments were administered only in person, participation was very low.*

**Green:** increased +5 or more

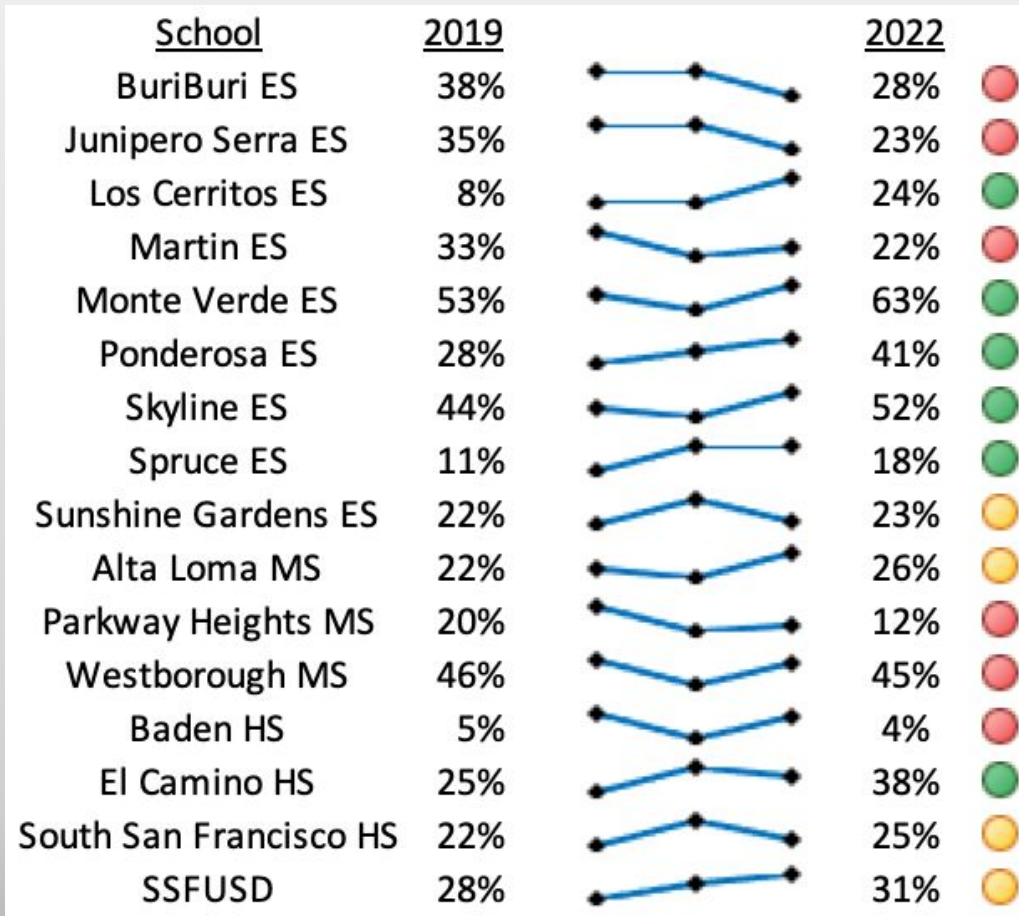
**Yellow:** maintained -2 to +4

**Red:** declined -5 or more



# CA Science Progress (2019 – 2022)

% of students meeting/exceeding standard (All Students in Testing Grades)



- From 2019 to 2022:
- 6 school improved by more than 5 percentage points
  - 3 schools maintained
  - 6 schools declined
  - 1 Target Student Group maintained; 2 declined

*Note: In 2021, due to distance learning and remote testing, participation rates in SSFUSD were below the target 95%, ranging from 29% to 96%.*

**Green:** increased +5 or more

**Yellow:** maintained -2 to +4

**Red:** declined -5 or more



# Key Takeaways

- Moving in the right direction: several target student groups and schools are making progress
- Performance in early grades among all student groups
- Mathematics is a continued focus
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade results show a need to focus on transition to middle school
- Progress in science with implementation of Next Generation Science Standards and instructional strategies
