


Welcome to MACCRAY!

Q: How do I keep track of my students?

- * **Infinite Campus has a great app that will notify parents when teachers submit grades or if a student is marked absent.**
 - Search "M.A.C.C.R.A.Y." to get your account set up. *(must use the periods!)*



Q: What is the school's laptop policy?

Chromebooks are a classroom tool!

It is students' responsibility to:

- Bring their chromebooks to school everyday fully charged.
- Take proper care of their chromebook
 - Be gentle! Chromebooks can and will break if you are rough with them.
- Lightspeed filter and monitoring will be used to track students' internet use.

Q: What is the school's Cell Phone Policy?

- ✓ Cell phones are NOT allowed to be used during class or in the halls.
- ✓ 12th grade students MUST check cell phones into classroom cubbies during class time.
- ✓ 6th-11th grade students MUST keep cell phones in their lockers.
- ✓ Students may check their phones in between classes and at lunch.
- ✓ If students do not follow the cell phone rules phones will be confiscated and PARENTS will be required to pick it up.



Q: How do I register for activities?

Register for activities on the MACCRAY website by visiting the [Activity Home Page](#)

- Athletes must have a current sports qualifying physical exam on file in the Activities Office. Physicals are good for 3 years from the date of your last physical.
- Once you have your physical completed by a doctor, you can turn it into the office or submit completed Physical forms online.



Q: What is the Attendance Policy?
