

How can you apply for the Early College Program?

During the Spring semester all 8th grade students must submit a CVECHS application form (which can be found in the CVECHS website). There are no criteria for placement into the Early College Program (except for the student's willingness to commit to this program).

Who can apply for the Early College Program?

Fabens or interested open enrollment students can apply. (If current freshmen students are interested in applying talk to the CVECHS counselor and/or the Director of program as soon as possible).

Summer Bridge Program:

The summer bridge program is mandatory. Incoming students must attend to gain a perspective of the expectations of what it would be like to being an early college student. The program includes visit to the EPCC Campus.
