Executive Board

President

Oversees and coordinates the work of the team to run MAP effectively. Serves as the official contact, communicator and representative of MAP. Works well with school leadership team and staff. Must be vetted through Superintendent.

- Term: 4-year commitment: President-Elect (year 1), President (2 years), Past President (1 year)
- Meetings: Attends Executive Board Meetings as scheduled & monthly MAP Meetings
- Time Commitment: 30 hours per month

President-Elect

Learns and collaborates with the current President of MAP to facilitate preparations for their upcoming term. Must work well with school leadership team and staff. Must be vetted through Superintendent.

- Term: 1-year commitment as President-Elect, President (2 Years), Past President (1 year)
- Meetings: Attends Executive Board Meetings as scheduled & monthly MAP meetings
- Time commitment: 10-15 hours per month

Past President

Serves as a resource and honorary advisor to both the MAP Board, MAP Executive Board, and the MAP President.

- Term:1-year commitment
- Meetings: Attend Executive Board Meetings as scheduled and monthly MAP meetings
- Time Commitment: 5 hours per month



Executive Board

Secretary

Takes minutes at association meetings. Handles MAP correspondence as directed by the President. Maintains and preserves MAP records and important documents to pass on at the end of the term.

- Term:2 years
- Meetings:
 - Attends Executive Board Meetings as scheduled & monthly MAP Meetings
- Time Commitment:
 - 2-5 hours per month

Treasurer

Spearheads the development of the MAP yearly budget. Keeps a record of all income received and expenditures by MAP. Provides a written treasurer's report at each meeting. Handles all reimbursements and tax-exempt items. Is point person with school accountant on the behalf of MAP.

- Term: 2 years
- Meetings:
 - Attends Executive Board Meetings as scheduled & monthly MAP Meetings
- Time Commitment:
 - 3 hours per month; 4 hours in July and January for reconciliation

Meet the MAP Board

Activities Coordinator

Organizes and assembles a team to coordinate a variety of school functions, such as carnivals and festivals. Responsible for managing event fundraising, if required.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team: Lead & Co-Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
 - Co-Lead attends monthly MAP meetings when Lead is not available
- Time Commitment:
 - o Lead: 1-2 hours per month
 - Co-Lead: 1-2 hours per month

Bless Our Teachers

Every month, we honor our teachers with breakfast, lunch, snacks, door prizes, or giveaways. We may require volunteers for decorating, set-up, or clean-up. The BOT Team will organize a sign-up and distribute it via Communications.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team: Lead & Co-Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
 - Co-Lead attends monthly MAP meetings when Lead is not available
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead: 15 hours per month (more if food is homemade; less if catered)
 - o Co-Lead: 5-10 hours per month



Communications

Handles the creation and distribution of all MAP-related media and marketing. This includes emails, The Compass Newsletter, website, social media, etc. Coordinates with the school marketing coordinator.

- Term: 2 year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team:Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
- Time Commitment: Minimum 15-20+ hours per month

Elementary Classroom Parent Coordinator

Coordinates the elementary classroom parents throughout the year with information about the class parties, how to assist the teacher with special events, and the teacher's birthday.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team:Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead: 1-2 hours per month; June-August is @ 10+ hours per month

Father's Club Chapter - Affiliate to MAP

A dad-led, grassroots effort creating simple ways for dads to be intentional with their KIDS, with other DADS and within their COMMUNITY.

- Term: 3 year commitment
- Team:Lead
- Meetings:
 - Optional for Lead to attend monthly MAP meeting
 - Time Commitment: 5+ hours per month



Locker Hugs

Locker Hugs are provided four times per school year. They are decorated, assembled, and then placed on secondary students' (6-12th grade) lockers. Volunteers may be required for decoration, set-up, and clean-up. The Locker Hug lead will organize a sign-up and distribute it via Communications.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team: Lead & Team Members
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
 - Team Members attend Locker Hug assembly meetings
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead: 4 hours for prep in September, December, February & May
 - Team: 2-3 hours for prep in September, December, February & May

Mom's Night Out

Organized regular events for MCA moms to come together and engage in various activities. These events will provide an opportunity for moms to bond over food, games, crafts, and other activities. To ensure participation, we recommend setting up a sign-up process and a small fee.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team:Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead: 2 hours per month; 15-20 hours per event in December & April



New to the Nest

This formal mentoring relationship is just one of many opportunities Maranatha offers to welcome, support and engage our newest families. New family mentors assist in building stronger engagement early in the new family's initiation into the school community by offering insight about the culture, building a faith-filled relationship and high-lighting resources provided by the school.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team: Lead & Team Members
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead: 1-2 hours per month
 - Team Members: 1+ hours per connection month

Parents in Prayer

Gather weekly at the school (or off-site) to pray for our school, community, and world.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team:Lead & Co-Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
 - Co-Lead attends monthly MAP meetings when Lead is not available
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead:1 hour per month plus weekly prayer meeting
 - Co-Lead: 1 hour per month plus weekly prayer meeting



Restaurant Nights

These events occur monthly throughout the year. They provide an opportunity for the school community to come together for a meal, raise funds for MAP events, and enjoy each other's company while supporting local businesses in the area.

- Term:1year commitment, not to exceed 2 years
- Team:Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead: 1-2 hours per month

Teacher Appreciation Week

Teacher Appreciation Week is a national holiday celebrated the first week of May. It honors the educators who inspire and equip our students to grow in their fullest potential. The Lead and Co-Lead put together a team while also opening it up to the school community as they see fit. Ideas range from meals, food/coffee trucks, flowers, words of encouragement, prayer, etc. Ending with a gift for each teacher and staff member.

- Term: 2 year commitment, not to exceed 3 years
- Team: Lead & Co-Lead
- Meetings:
 - Lead attends monthly MAP meetings
 - Co-Lead attends monthly MAP meetings when Lead is not available
- Time Commitment:
 - Lead: 1-2 hours per month; April & May @ 30 hours per month
 - o Co-Lead: 1-2 hours per month; April & May @ 30 hours per month



Teacher's P.E.T.

The P.E.T. acronym stands for Pray. Encourage. Treat. At the beginning of each school year, MCA faculty and staff members are chosen by a Maranatha family who will bless/treat their chosen teacher throughout the year. The Teacher's P.E.T. program kindly requests that the Maranatha family treats their chosen faculty and/or staff member five times a year, but it is not limited to only those five times. These acts of support include celebrating Back-To-School, Birthdays, Christmas, Valentine's Day, and Teacher Appreciation Week. Notably, the identity of the MCA family is revealed during Teacher Appreciation Week, when it becomes known that they have been quietly supporting their chosen faculty or staff member throughout the year.

- The resource must support pre-written grade-level (elementary) or subject-area (secondary) objectives as written in Curriculum Trak.
- The resource must be pre-approved by the divisional principal.
- Elementary classroom grants should either be
 - o for something that can be shared by all sections of the grade or
 - o be within cost for each classroom to be provided with the resource or
 - o to enhance a special class or
 - o to support student play on the playground
- Secondary grants should support any subject area or activity supported on Curriculum Trak or within the Flight Centre.

October 15, 2024
