
Arrival and Dismissal

- **All students should arrive at 8:50 a.m. each day!** School ends at 3:37p.m.
- **The first day of school for students is THURSDAY, September 4, 2025, which is a FULL DAY ending at 3:37p.m.**
- Students that walk to school should be accompanied by their parent to cross the street or use the crossing guard. Students that are dropped off must keep traffic moving.
- **Doors open at 8:50 a.m. (See attached for Morning and Afternoon Dismissal procedures.)**
- To maintain safety and security, **no parents will be allowed to enter the building on the first days of school.** Teachers and staff will walk children to their classrooms.
- *Should you arrive late to school, simply buzz the front door and a staff member will greet you and walk your child to class. Have your ID ready just in case.*



Classroom Assignment:

- Your child's teacher will be: **Ms. «Teacher» Room: «HR» ☺** Your child's teacher will send home other important documents and a *school planner for you to sign and read* during the opening weeks of school. Please pay close attention to all school correspondence and information!
- ***If your child is a kindergarten student, you will find a name tag enclosed. Please have your child wear this name tag for the first two weeks of school!***



Meals:

- A new FOOD SERVICES application must be filled out each year online.
- If your child is bringing lunch, they should bring it in a lunch container they can be responsible for and open independently. Otherwise, consider sending in disposable lunch items!
- Meals cannot be warmed or microwaved for ANY student.
- **Breakfast begins September 08, 2025. You must pay for breakfast in the student portal.**

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What if my child is sick?:



- Each family must **report** if a child has **temperature of 100.4** degrees or more and **keep the child(ren) at home**.
- Call the Main Office if your child(ren) has/have a fever.
- If a child becomes sick at school, they will be sent to the school nurse and she will contact the family to pick up.
- Any person who leaves with a fever must return with a doctor's note to return to school **after 24 hours without medication**.

Uniforms:

- There is a district wide **uniform policy** for all elementary (K-3) students. Your child is required to wear: a dark blue collared polo shirt and either dark blue or khaki slacks, shorts, or skorts/skirts, jumpers for girls.

Slacks - Shorts
Jumper - Skirt

- **Kindergarten Students should send in extra clothes (if needed, in case of an accident) that will be kept in the classroom in the cubby. Put in a large Ziploc bag with name clearly labeled.**
- **No CROCS.** Students go outside daily for recess and have gym weekly. **Sneakers are preferred.**



Emotional Support for our Students:

- In order to meet the social and emotional needs of our students, we are planning to have resources available to them during the school.
- Counselors, case managers, and other student support staff are available for students at all times!
- All staff have been provided with professional development on how to meet the social and emotional needs of our students.

Transportation:

- The transportation department will send out busing information to those who need it.
- Seats will be assigned.

Miscellaneous:

- Our **OPTIONAL** Supply lists are provided on our website. If there is anything that your teacher needs for a specific project or assignment during the year, he/she will provide detailed instructions.
- **Class Dojo** will be used by all teachers this year to communicate! More information will come from your teacher.



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
- **KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION is Wednesday, August 27, 2025 at 6:00pm! See flyer enclosed!**
